The note sheet is the format in which the songs are recorded down. The note sheet begins with an empty staff music paper consisting of graphs that have five rows and four spaces, each of which Note. Songwriters who compose songs in standard musical notation use regular paper to create notes that can then be passed on to musicians who interpret notes for musical performance. Today, making your own notes easier than ever. With notation software such as finale, or free web service Noteflight, everyone can turn their musical ideas into professional music sheets. Use Noteflight to get started (see Resources). Noteflight is a free music note service that lets you write, print, and even save notes as music files to play. Noteflight has a clean, easy-to-use interface that allows even a beginner to create a song in notes. Since Noteflight allows you to listen to what you've written, you can experiment with different notes until you create something that sounds good, even if you're not familiar with the music. Create a Noteflight account and log in to start creating your own note. You can start writing your song immediately. After the success of Czech rhapsody and Oscar-winning performance by Rami Malek star Freddie Mercury, rumors about the sequel of Czech rhapsody did not seem so far away. Will they make Czech rhapsody 2? Rami Malek John Lamparski/Wirelmage Bohemian Rhapsody could continue with Mercury, and the story of the queen has always been fascinating, and the filmmakers have done an exceptional job it screened last year in Czech Rhapsody. Czech Rhapsody ended with this statement: Freddie Mercury died of AIDS-related pneumonia on 24 November 1991. He was 45 years old. In addition, Bohemian Rhapsody was nominated for best film, won four Oscars, and was the highest-grossing musical biopic ever, earning \$850 million, so the sequel could be a successful start. Rumors of Czech Rhapsody 2 make the rounds According to Page Six exclusive, Rudy Dolezal, director of dozens of music videos of the queen noted that the sequel was largely discussed in the queen's family. Dolezal shared the queen's manager Jim Beach: I'm sure he's planning a sequel that starts with Live Aid. The music video director teamed up with the queen during a Live Aid performance and made 30 videos for the band and its members, including Mercury's These Are the Days of Our Lives in 1991. Mercury died the same year. Dolezal's comment about the sequel seemed to be supported by the band's guitarist Brian May, hinting at a sequel, as he noted last year: I think Live Aid is a good time to leave it. Who knows, there might be a sequel. Page Six further reports that Malek said he had not heard anything about the sequel, and there was no label for the queen. There will be a special airing on ABC in April, however, titled The Show Must Go On: The queen and Adam Lambert story. Bohemian Rhapsody sequel rumors closed until the idea of bohemian Rhapsody 2 received too much publicity, a publicist for producer Graham King said there was no truth in the Czech rhapsody sequel to the rumors, according to Slash Film. There is more of Freddie Mercury's story to be told in the absence of a sequel to Czech Rhapsody, there is even more mercury story to tell as Dolezal revealed that he is writing a book called My Friend, Freddie and plans to release an interview he has with Mercury in the film Freddie Mercury: In His Own Words.
