- The provisional system that provided the presence of God was called the t_____ or s_____ (Exodus 25:8).

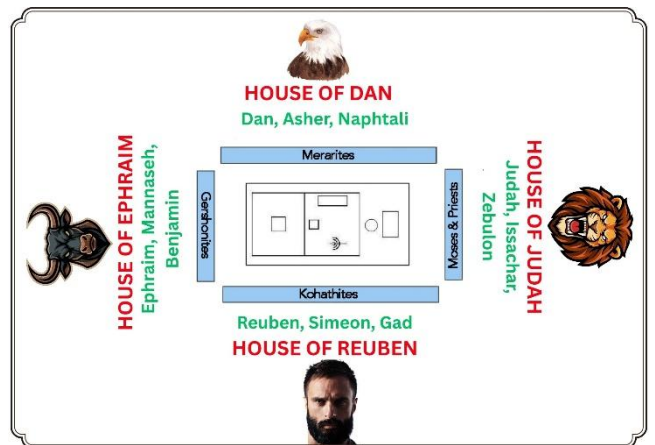
II. The King's Presence Must Be in a T_____
