Election - March General Dinner meeting – 3/10/2026

This is to notify you that at the March 10, 2026, General Dinner meeting an election for the position of Secretary will be conducted. The following individual will be considered to fill the open Secretary's position – **Steve Gandolfo**

Alert: By-Law Modification

Per ARTICLE IX of the By-laws, you are formally being notified that the following revisions (In RED) to the By-Laws are under consideration.

At the March General Dinner meeting, the membership will vote on whether or not, the following By-Laws will be amended.

ARTICLE VI - Meeting and Elections

Recommended Amendment **three-year requirement** will be reduced to **two**.

Section 2. All Officers and Directors for the Corporation shall be a least twenty-one (21) years of age and shall have been a member in good standing in the Corporation for at least **three two years** preceding the date of the election. The President of the Corporation shall be a citizen of the United States. **Two years vs Three years.**

ARTICLE IV

Government and Management Section 7.

Recommended Amendment: All other expenditures and disbursements **in excess of \$10,000.00** shall be authorized and approved by a majority of the members of the Corporation present at the meeting.

The Board of Directors shall perform any and all duties imposed on them collectively or individually by law, by the Articles of Incorporation, or by these By-Laws. They shall have the authority to appoint and remove, employ and discharge, and except as otherwise provided by these By-Laws, prescribe the duties and fix the compensation, if any of all officers, agents, and employees of the Corporation to assure that their duties are performed properly. They shall have the authority to approve and direct the payment of all current ordinary expenses (including repairs and maintenance) of the Corporation. Expenditures or disbursements for capital assets or improvements shall be sent out for bid, and the Board shall report on the bids and make their recommendations to the members. Any selected bid must be approved by a majority of the members of the Corporation present at the meeting. All other expenditures and disbursements **in excess of \$10,000.00** shall be authorized and approved by a majority of the members of the Corporation present at the meeting.




