Professional travel companionship is a premium service and costs typically include:

- Professional fees for companionship services (expect a fee similar to executive chauffeur journeys)
- Travel expenses
- Accommodation
- Transportation and activities
- Dining

Most providers offer bespoke quotations based on specific requirements rather than published rates.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN A TRAVEL COMPANION

Professional Background

Look for companions with significant professional experience, or relevant qualifications that ensure exceptional service with warmth and approachability.

Personal Qualities

The ideal companion combines attention to detail with adaptability, expertise with warmth, and anticipates needs while remaining unobtrusive.

Availability and Focus

Quality companions typically accept limited engagements annually to ensure dedicated attention to each client.

Verification and References

Ensure your companion has appropriate insurance, can provide references, and has relevant credentials.

Family Involvement

Adult children with demanding careers often initiate these arrangements, wanting their parents to enjoy travel with proper support. When choosing a service, consider:

- Communication protocols between companion and family
- Emergency procedures
- Balance between family reassurance and traveller autonomy

QUESTIONS FOR POTENTIAL COMPANIONS

Most importantly, after spending some time learning about them as well as speaking to them, will you feel comfortable spending extended periods of time with them?

- What is their personal background?
- What is their professional background?
- Will they provide you with a full and verifiable personal and professional biography?
- What is their practical experience of local, national and international travel?
- What is their experience of working with seniors?
- What are their expert / speciality areas of travel?
- How clear are the costs of their service?
- How will they structure your travel adventure?
- What are the accommodation arrangements?
- How are expenses handled?
- What happens in case of emergency?
- How are family communications to be managed?
- What insurance coverage is in place?
- How do they demonstrate confidence and competence?
- Can they offer a door-to-door service regardless of where the ultimate destination is?
