Nintendo versions of the game were released by Bandai, while Sega versions were published by Sega themselves. The Green Ranger only play on Genesis and Game Gear versions of the game. Super NES First Level in the Super NES version of the game featuring the list of Rangers and Jason Fight Putty Patroler Super NES version of Mighty Morphin Power Rangers is a spin-off action game comprised of seven stages, with two different styles of gameplay. Four reviewers of Electronic Gaming Monthly gave the game Super NES a score of 6.5 out of 10, but unanimously negative rating, saying that it has poor animation and boring level design and is just too easy for experienced players. They praised the character selection feature, but came to the conclusion that even Power Ranger fans would find the game interesting only for a short time. Nintendo Magazine System gave the game a total score of 77, describing difficulty as powerful hard. Praise has been given an energetic presentation and style akin to a TV show, fluid control and animation, as well as attention to detail in making each character unique with trademark moves. One reviewer gave Bandai credit for a genuine attempt at something vaguely special, calling the end result pretty

cool, while another reviewer dubbed the game unoriginal. Another criticism was directed at the old-fashioned gameplay and repetitive feel, with the final consensus being that the game was more for hardcore fans than hardcore gamers. The Game Boy The Game Boy version is a side scrolling action game similar to the SNES game, but much more simplistic. There are five levels, each of which consists of two segments. In the Rangers segment, any of the five original rangers must pass the level by defeating putty patrols. Using the choice button opens up their unique weapon, but depletes health with each use. The second segment is a Megazord fight against the show's main villains. When playing Super Game Boy, unique color palettes can be used with each ranger. Genesis The Sega Genesis/Mega Drive is a one-on-one competitive combat game featuring two different modes of play: a scenario mode in which the player competes with a series of CPU-controlled opponents and a two-player combat mode. In script mode, the matches consist of two segments: the player will fight against the usual size monster as one of the Rangers, and after defeating the monster they will fight a giant version of it. Initially, only five original Rangers and Megazord are available, but once the Green Ranger is defeated, he and Dragonzord are unlocked. GamePro cooked games, mostly for one-dimensional gameplay and unbalanced difficulty. Game Gear In this version, the player has three main attacks (one of which is done by pressing two action buttons at the same time), a throw and three special moves on the character. The Game Gear version has more levels and enemies than the Genesis version. The game consists of three modes of the game: the eponymous story game, which includes a series of story battles against the band of enemies, the eponymous player against the game, and the two-needle game Link, in which two players fight each other using a cable connection. Like the Genesis version, Green Ranger and Dragonzord (including Dragonzord Battle Mode) become unlocked after a story defeat. GamePro described the game as a satisfying combination of fighting and adventure, perfect for beginners. They noted that the game's history mode is simplistic and very easy but enjoyable, and reinforced by the ability to control any of the Power Rangers in other modes of play. Electronic gaming monthly praised the large number of moves and ability as a Megazord, and Game 6.2 out of 10.
