As we begin to gather indoors, what is one of the best ways that I can love others well?

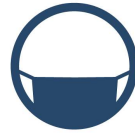
If you are experiencing symptoms of fever, cough, chills, sore throat, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea or new loss of taste or smell, please stay home. If you have tested positive for COVID in the last 14 days or have been exposed to someone that has, please stay home. If you have traveled internationally in the last 14 days, please stay home.

WHAT SHOULD I DO BEFORE I COME TO CHURCH?

We ask that you take your temperature. If your temperature is at or above 100.4, or if you know you have been exposed to someone who is Covid19-positive, please stay home. If not, please join us! Please use the bathroom at home and bring a mask with you.



WILL I BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK AT CHURCH?

YES

Please bring a mask and wear it at all times in the building. Children under the age of 2 are welcome to attend and should NOT wear a mask.



WILL I BE NEED TO REGISTER FOR ONE OF THE SERVICES?

YES

Please use our reopen.church registration signup ahead of time so that we can regulate our congregation size and maintain adequate social distancing.

WILL THERE BE SCREENING AS PEOPLE ENTER?

NO

To avoid creating a bottleneck when people enter, we will not do temperature screening at the door. Instead, we ask everyone who attends to check for temperature and Covid-like symptoms before coming.

WILL THERE BE COFFEE?

NO

We will not be providing coffee until further notice. Because we are wearing masks, please do not bring beverages in with you.



WILL THE SERVICE STILL BE AVAILABLE ONLINE?

YES

The service will be live streamed at 9:00am and then will be available online after it concludes.

We want to be sure that we are caring for one another well, in every possible way.



WILL RESTROOMS BE OPEN?

YES

However, please use the bathroom before you leave home, in order to minimize the usage of our bathrooms.



WILL THERE BE MUSIC?

YES

There will be a combination of music presentation by the worship team at the beginning, and the congregation will be invited to stand and join in singing at the end of the service.



WILL THE LENGTH OF THE SERVICE BE THE SAME?

NO

Services will run a bit shorter in length to minimize the amount of time we are gathered, per recommendations.



WHEN WE DISMISS, WILL WE ALL BE IN THE FELLOWSHIP HALL TOGETHER?

NO

Everyone will be asked to exit the building once they are dismissed. Dismissal will be channeled through two exit points in order to limit traffic and congestion.



WILL SEATING BE SOCIALLY DISTANCED?

YES

Similar to our use of cones outdoors, we'll use tape to indicate the designated areas allowing families to sit together and remain socially distanced from those around them.



WILL THERE BE NURSERY CARE?

NO

There will not be any nursery care or classes until further notice.

WILL THERE BE A PLACE FOR MOTHERS TO NURSE A BABY?

YES

We will have a couple of rooms available that will be a "one at-a-time" space for any moms that need to nurse a baby.
