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
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


1. **Tutorial Videos:** Watch step-by-step video tutorials that guide you through each Canva design project.





GETTING STARTED WITH THIS WORKBOOK

Course Overview and Lesson Flow

Welcome to **Learn Canva for Students!** In this course, students will learn the basics of graphic design while creating real projects using Canva. Each lesson includes a short video tutorial and a hands-on activity to help students practice new design skills step-by-step. By the end of this book, students will have completed **32 design projects** and built a portfolio of creative work.

LESSON FLOW

Each lesson follows the same simple steps:

1. **Access the Tutorial and Template.** Scan the QR code or visit the lesson link to access the step-by-step video tutorial and Canva template. Download the template before starting so you can follow along with the lesson.
2. **Watch the Tutorial.** Play the tutorial video and pause along the way to follow the steps and complete the design as it is demonstrated.
3. **Follow the Activity Checklist.** Use the checklist while watching the tutorial to stay on track and complete each step of the design.
4. **Learn a Business Tip.** Some lessons include tips about branding, marketing, and creating designs that could be used for real businesses or makers markets.
5. **Sketch Your Ideas.** Use the sketch page to plan your layout, colors, and design before creating it in Canva.
6. **Create Your Own Version.** Use your sketch and the skills you learned in the tutorial to design your own unique version in Canva.
7. **Complete the Design Review.** Use the design review checklist to check your work before submitting your design to a teacher or sharing it with others.
8. **Build Your Portfolio.** Print your final design and place it on the portfolio page. Use the reflection questions on the portfolio page to think about what you did well and what you could improve next time.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The projects in this book are organized into two sections designed to be taught over two semesters for a full-year graphic design course.

- **Unit 1: Creative Design Projects** - Students practice design skills such as fonts, colors, layouts, and images while creating fun and engaging designs.
- **Unit 2: Business & Branding Projects** - Students create designs that could be used for real businesses, makers markets, or entrepreneurial ideas.

CLASS USE & CREDIT SUGGESTIONS

- **Upper Elementary (Grades 4–6):** Digital Design or Computer Class enrichment.
- **Middle School (Grades 6–8):** Intro to Graphic Design – 1 Middle School Elective.
- **High School (Grades 9–12):** Digital Graphic Design or Digital Media – approximately 0.5 High School Elective Credit (up to 1.0 credit with extended business projects).

HELPFUL TIPS BEFORE YOU BEGIN

1. Use Two Devices for Ease

Scan the QR code or watch the video in the Canva Template using a separate device (such as a phone or tablet). This allows you to watch the tutorial while following along on your computer. For classroom or co-op use, the video may also be downloaded from Loom or streamed to a TV or Smartboard.

2. Canva for Educators & Students

Canva offers a free version for educators and students! Once set up, you can assign this project as Solo Work, giving each student their own editable copy of the template. This makes it easy for students to work independently and personalize their designs.

3. Canva for Homeschool Co-ops

Homeschool co-ops registered as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit may also qualify for Canva for Nonprofits, which provides access to many premium features at no cost. Check Canva's official website for current eligibility and application details.

4. Free Account? No Problem!

If you're using a Canva Basic (free) account, you can still follow along with most of the tutorials. Just make sure to select elements marked as free when creating your own designs. Also, when it's time to download your project, choose to download only your page. Otherwise, Canva may prompt you to upgrade or pay a fee.

5. Access the Templates & Video

Visit the website listed in this book and enter the password provided on the back page to access the tutorial videos and Canva templates. You may also scan the QR code to go directly to the site.



