Successful vendors need to ensure that payment for their stalls is made at the vendor's meeting on **Friday**, **2 October 2020**. Meeting and payment details will be included in your confirmation /email.

1. **Power:** The maximum amount of power that will be available for each stall is **7200W.** Please ensure you check the amount of watts/amps your equipment requires (normally found on a sticker on the back or bottom of the appliance) and ensure the total does not exceed the allocation. All appliances you intend to use at the festival must have been tested and tagged by a qualified electrician in the past 12 months. Appliances will be checked before they are plugged in to ensure power continuity at the event.
