In the spirit of transparency, the Diocese of Cheyenne reports that Reverend Eckley Macklin (85 years old) has been restricted from public ministry due to a credible allegation of sexual abuse of a minor in the Diocese of Corpus Christi. Rev. Macklin is a priest of the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity (SOLT). The alleged incident of abuse did not take place within the Diocese of Cheyenne; however, [he served in the Diocese of Cheyenne from 2003-2015 in the parishes of St. Ann in Saratoga; St. Joseph in Lovell, St. Stephens Mission in St. Stephens; and St. Margaret in Riverton.](#) Anyone who has suffered sexual abuse should contact the local law enforcement agency or the Department of Family Services.
