Mehr ansehen Buford Dam Road travellers beware. Starting Monday, part of the well-traveled corridor will be closed for months. Gerald Blackburn, Cumming's city administrator, said the planned closure between Sanders Road and Market Place Boulevard would begin Monday morning. The detour will include Sanders and Mary Alice Park Roads, and Hwys. 9 and 20. The road closure is expected to last about four months as crews work to replace the culvert near where it crosses Market Place. The overall Buford Dam Road project, which spans from Sanders to Hwy. 9, includes widening the road to four lanes and installing sidewalks. This is projected to cost about \$3.8 million, about \$1.8 million State. Construction on the other side of the highway, from Market Place to Hwy. 9, will continue for the same four-month period as the closure. This, however, will not require a shutdown. Assistant City manager Steve Bennett said the stretch would instead include include single-lane traffic and flagships, leading cars. Increase the scale closer or update How to use the Forsyth County Traffic Traffic Flow: Red Lines - Heavy Traffic Flow, Yellow/Orange Lines - Medium Stream and Green - Normal Traffic. Black lines or no traffic lines may indicate a closed road, but in most cases this means that either there is not enough traffic flow to register or traffic is not controlled. Also, if you don't see the flow of traffic, you can zoom closer to reveal localized data. If you can't pan the map, click here (to focus on the map) and try again. Traffic Accidents (beta): Each point is a traffic event or incident such as road construction, closure or accident. With a closer increase in levels, these points can be pressed to see more information. Once a layer of traffic information has popped up, be sure to click/click any additional arrows (like 1 of 3) in the top right above the header to see other impact details.
