



Favors' Friends Social Skills Scholarships

Agape Consulting is a nonprofit organization providing resources to communities impacted by children with special needs both locally and abroad. Because of the lack of daycare providers with programs geared toward children with disabilities, Agape Consultant provides affordable programs for children in the community. The Favor's Friends Social Skills program is a program design to facilitate social interaction between children using Applied Behavior Analytical principles. In order to assist families in need, Agape Consulting offers scholarships are available for children in need of services. This scholarship application form must be submitted to prior to each semester program in order to be selected.

Scholarship Funding Breakdown

Favors' Friends Social Skills Preschool Day Programs are 3 hour long group sessions containing no more than 8 children and include crafts, music, game play and/or free play. Each session is led by a lead teacher and an assistant teacher. Data is taken to record progress for each child.

Preschool Age Day Program

- \$3,200** - 1 Semester Full Scholarship for Preschool Age Social Skills Day Program
- \$640** - 1 Month Full Scholarship for Preschool Age Social Skills Day Program
- \$320** - 1 Month Partial Scholarship for Preschool Age Social Skills Day Program
- \$160** - 1 Week Scholarship of Preschool Age Social Skills Day Program

Favors' Friends Social Skills School Age Program are 1 and a half hour long group sessions, primarily held on weekends, containing no more than 8 children and include crafts, music, game play and/or free play. Each session is led by a lead teacher and an assistant teacher. Data is taken to record progress for each child.

School Age Weekend Program

- \$250** - 1 Semester (10 Sessions) Full Scholarship
- \$125** - 1 Semester (10 Sessions) Partial Scholarship
- \$50** - 1 month (2 Sessions) Full Scholarship
- \$25** - 1 month (2 Sessions) Partial Scholarship
- \$25** - 1 Day Drop-in Scholarship

Scholarship Qualifications

Scholarships eligibility will be assessed based on needs of the child and income qualification guidelines. Our guidelines mirror that of government assistance programs. Those who wish to apply will need to meet the following criteria for approval. Those who currently receive government funded benefits such as TANF, SNAP and Medicare are automatically eligible for the scholarship.

In order for your application to be processed, you must provide:

- Information about your child, Fill in the number of family members in your household (family includes people related by birth, marriage, or adoption who live together)
- Information about your family's gross monthly income (income before taxes and deductions)**

- 2 months of employment pay stubs or

Notification of Scholarship Award: Prior to each semester, a review of available funding will be done and awarding of scholarships will be done based upon need. Once a scholarship is offered you will have 5 business days to accept the offer, before the offer is rescinded. As more funding becomes available notices will be sent out to applicants notifying them of more opportunities.
