If you miss out on any performances, the first phase channel will also revive shows from the preceding day until Lollapalooza re-announces during the afternoon. Plus, they're accessible both via web and mobile app, so you can catch up on your movie tycoon at any time. HotstarIndia's most popular streaming platform offers a mixture of free and premium content, with the free level more than worth you while. While some movies are only available to users with a Premium subscription, there are many titles that you can stream completely free, from dramas to excitement to biopics to children's movies. The service also offers TV shows and sports live streaming, for a complete entertainment experience, so it's hard to run out of content to watch, even with a free account. That said, a Hotstar Premium subscription comes with access to English TV shows and movies as well as the latest Hindi and regional releases. If you are serious about keeping the world from cinema, INR199/month should not break the bank. The Premium subscription comes with a seven-day free trial. Hotstar will charge the full amount of your card, but will offer a refund if you cancel before your free Premium Week.NetflixNetflix can govern the streaming market at a global level, but the service doesn't fare particularly well in India. Its cheapest subscription plan costs INR500/month, which is significantly more expensive than the competition. Yet the platform invests heavily in original content and has a large catalogue of movies available in India, so it can be worth a try. After all, Roma brought Netflix his first Oscar nomination for best picture, so the future looks bright. Netflix India is free to try for an entire month. Amazon Prime VideoAccess to Prime Video is free with an Amazon Prime subscription, priced at INR129/month or INR999/year. You get a one-month free trial, so you can use Prime Video's spacious catalog of content – which includes popular regional movies and Hollywood blockbusters. Moreover, Amazon Prime brings you free, fast delivery on suitable items and additional benefits such as ad-free music streaming. If you shop a lot online, access a whole library of movies & TV shows as a bonus worth a prime subscription. JioCinemaJioCinema brings your tons of movies across all genres, content from Disney India – which means you can stream as many Marvel blockbusters and Disney classics as you can handle. Even better, JioCinema is totally free to use – the only catch is that it's only available to Jio customers. Your Jio credentials (telephone number or Jio ID) will be expected to stream content. Still, if you already have Jio, getting access to hundreds of movies available for free is a nice limit. HAOQHOOQ advertises as your gateway to a world of unlimited entertainment, and its catalog backs on the claim. The service, which comes with a one-month free trial, allows you to stream a wide range of both movies and TV series, including Hollywood hits. Once your free trial is over, a HOOQ subscription will reset you inR89/month. The platform also allows you to hire the most recent releases fresh from the cinema, generally for INR59 each. VootVoot is a totally free on-demand streaming service, which offers movies in several languages (Hindi, Kannada, Bengali and more), with a special category for children. You can also stream TV shows, music videos, or various tracks, so you'll never run out of content to watch with this one. You can register an account to keep better track of what you're watching, but it's completely up to you. The only downside is that you will have to endure ads, but it is a small price to pay to access such a large library of content for free. Sony LivSs on other platforms on the list, Sony Liv hosts a mix of free and premium content, but plenty of movies are available to stream at no cost. However, if you are looking for a Hollywood release, you need to get a Premium subscription, which costs INR99/month. You can browse and watch the platform without creating an account, but to register with the service unlock additional features such as adding a video in which you are interested in watching later. BigFlixBigFlix comes with a one-month free trial run, which is more than enough time to marathon some of the titles in the platform's catalogue. Movies are available in several languages, which is a big plus. You can create a free account, but it only allows you to check trailers. If you sign up for a Premium subscription, you'll get a whole month for free and you can cancel at any time. After that, if you decide to retain the service, you will pay INR50/month or INR500/year. Zee5Zee5 offers a wide range of content, from movies to TV shows, original productions and news. A lot of it is free (with ads), so you can stream movies without paying anything (you don't even have to register for an account). If you're interested in some of the platform's Premium offers, you'll have to pay inR99/month. SpuulSpuul offers more than 10,000 hours of Bollywood movies, and some of them are completely free Content for users without an account is limited, but should help you decide whether a Spuul subscription, priced on INR 99/month, is worth the investment. To get started, all you have to do is navigate to Browse, and then click Free Movies. You will have to sign in via Facebook or create an account by subscribing with your email to watch. ViuWith Viu, you get access to a limited amount of free content, including a generous number of movies. You can stream them without creating an account and the interface is user-friendly, so it's easy to see what's offered and settled on a title. If you want a Premium subscription, it costs INR99/two months. Tubi TVTubi TV allows you to watch free movies and TV shows without a subscription, no strings attached. You can browse through various categories, including Family Movies, Romance, Horror, and more. The service is completely free – you don't even have to register for an account if you don't feel like it. TV shows are also available on the platform. MUBIMUBI is proud of hosting truly great theatre, which translates to cult, classical, independent and award-winning films from around the world. A subscription costs INR500/month and buys your access to 30 movies, a new one added every day. You get a seven-day free trial, so you have a week to watch some movies and decide if they're on your own. HungamaAlJe mainly offers a music streaming service. Hungama also hosts movies and TV shows at the moment so you can enjoy a variety of content, much of it for free. Simply browse through the movie section, settle on a free title and you are good to go. Alternatively, you can purchase a subscription, which comes with unlimited access to the platform's catalogue. Movies & TV shows cost INR99/month, while Entertainment Unlimited costs INR149/month (includes music downloads and more). Hungama also allows you to pay for your subscription with Hungama coins, which can be earned by spending time on the platform (registering for an account, playing a song and so on). HoichoiHoichoi offers an impressive collection of Bengali movies, but most of them are only available if you get a subscription. However, a small selection of titles is available for free – simply browse the Movie Category until you find the Free Movies section. If you enjoy the service, a subscription costs INR399/year. MuvizzMuvizz specializes in cult, classical and independent films. Some titles are available for free, while others need a subscription, priced on INR80/month. You can browse the platform's library to see what's available and decide if the Premium titles are worth your cash. YouTubeWhile YouTube mainly specializes in short(er) videos and original content created by the community, if you're patient enough, you can also stumble on movies. Some are legal On YouTube, others ... not so much. It can also be difficult to see false and so; Plus Plus nothing more annoying than realizing that you don't have access to the whole movie after you start watching. We will be remiss not to include YouTube, but we strongly recommend that you give the other platforms on the list a chance as well. Well.
