10 Things God Asks of Young Adults



To complete this series of 3 articles, here is what God requires of those who are not yet fathers or mothers.

- 1 Be an example - Timothy 4:12 Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.
2. Enjoy your relationship with the Lord - Ecclesiastes 12:1 Remember also your Creator in the days of your youth, before the evil days come and the years draw near of which you will say, "I have no pleasure in them".
3. Practise the Word - Psalm 119:9 - How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word.
4. Overcome lust - 2 Timothy 2:22 So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.
- 5 Be kind and humble - Micah 6:8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?
6. Trust the Lord - Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.
7. Fulfill your youth - Lamentations 3:27 It is good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.
8. Renew your strength - Isaiah 40:29-31 Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.
9. Manage your anger - Ecclesiastes 11:10 Remove vexation from your heart, and put away pain from your body, for youth and the dawn of life are vanity.
10. Persevere - Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own.

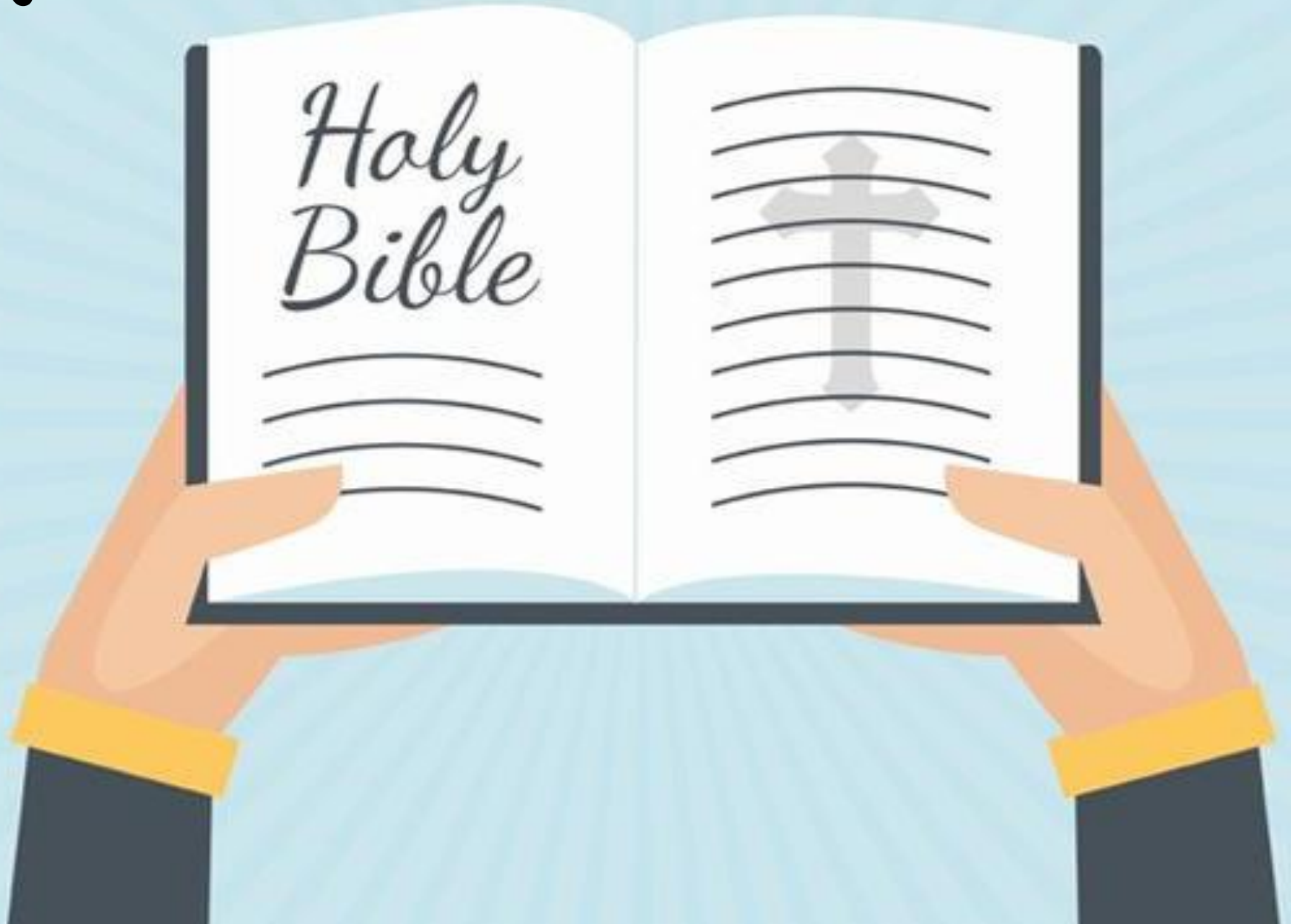

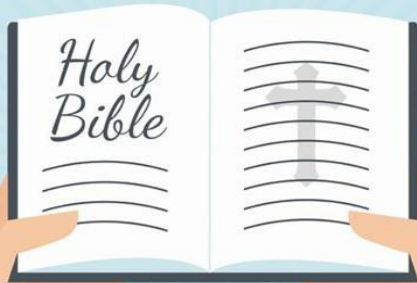

Started preaching at 18, that's 61 years

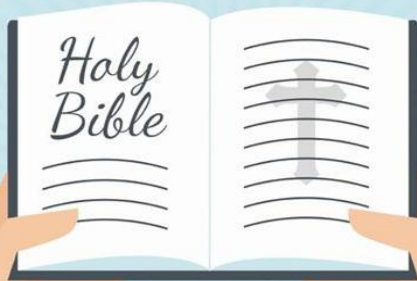
What would I say, if I had 1 sermon left

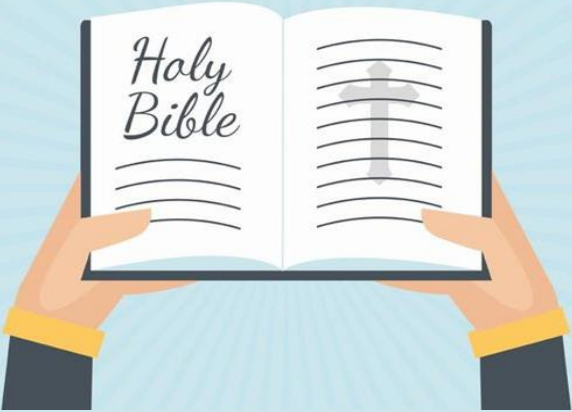

Believe also in me.*

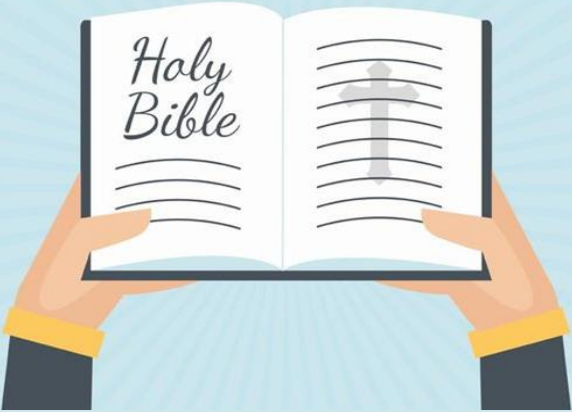
In my Father's house are many mansions.

All the toil of man is for his mouth, yet his appetite is not satisfied.

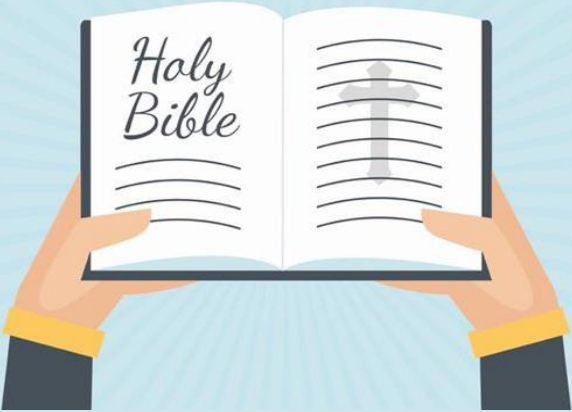

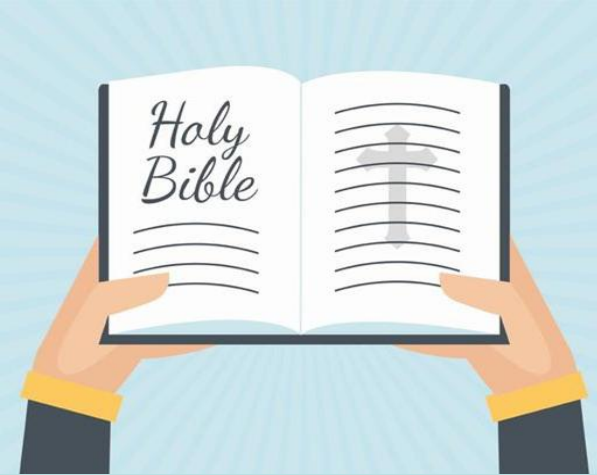
Recognize that Jesus is the way

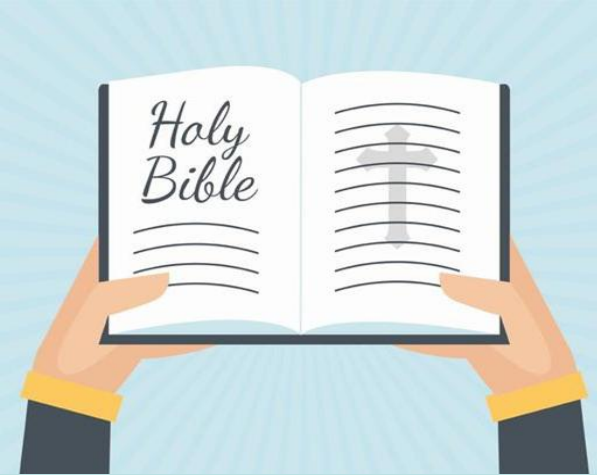

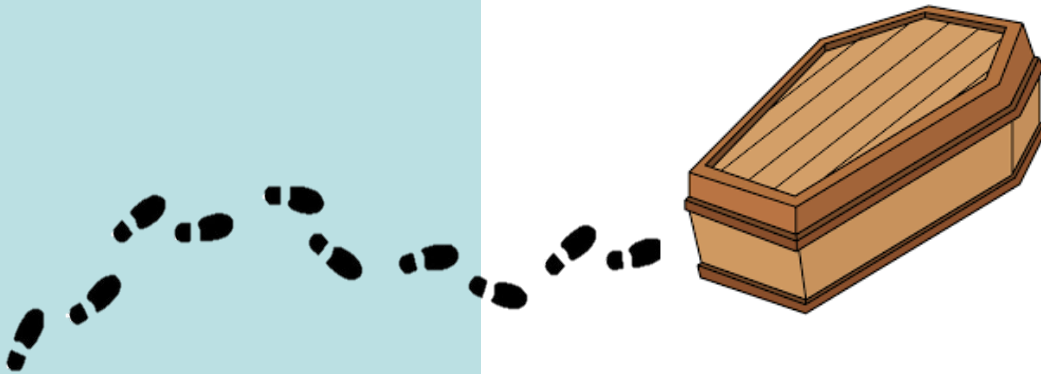

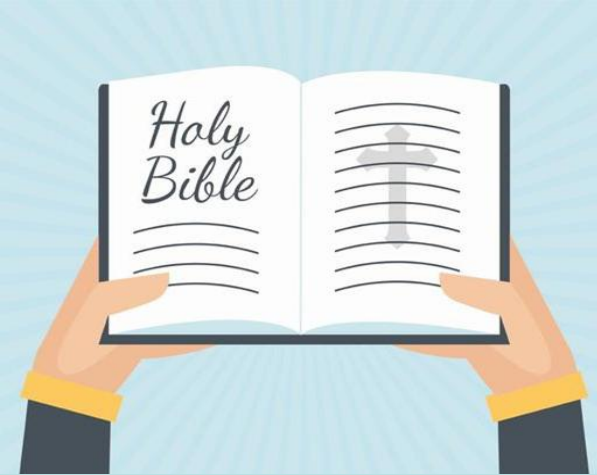
