Why do I have to pay to get certain books? Microsoft Corp.'s search engine Bing is no longer available in Apple's iTunes store because of a patent dispute over Bing's algorithms, the company said on Wednesday. Customers of Apple's App Store will continue to find Bing and its other search offerings, Microsoft said. The iTunes store, Apple's software store for digital music, movies, books, games and TV shows, allows its customers to buy and download only the apps, music, movies, books and games that meet the high standards set by Apple. Microsoft's Bing is not included in the store. Other popular search engines include Google, Yahoo and Ask. Customer Reviews Microsoft's Bing search engine is no longer available in the Apple iTunes Store. The online music store says the decision was made because of a patent dispute with Microsoft. "We have received a few inquiries regarding Bing, which we appreciate, but it is not currently available on iTunes," a spokesperson for Apple said. Bing is not on the list of available search engines on iTunes' main screen. It is available in the product search box on iTunes, which can be opened by clicking the magnifying glass icon in the top right corner of the window. For some apps, you can search Google, Yahoo, Ask and Bing at the same time. For others, you can choose a different search engine from a list. Other Web sites and Apps Apple allows developers to create applications for the iPhone, iPod touch and the iPad, which can be downloaded from Apple's iTunes store. Google's Android platform is also available in the iTunes store. Users can browse the iTunes store for free but apps have to be purchased to download. Bing was launched in 2009. The Google search engine is part of the Google Web property, which is part of Google Inc.
