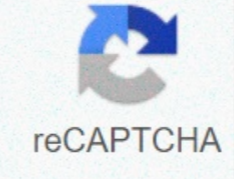

As a result of COVID-19, students who need to pick up prescriptions from the ISU Pharmacy can either come in person during regular business hours or call (309) 438-8709 to schedule a pickup. Our pharmacy staff will be able to work with you over the phone and carry out your pharmacy transaction. Once your transaction is complete and you arrive at the Student Services Building, call the pharmacy again and an employee will meet you at the western door of the building (closest to the parking lot) and bring your prescription to you. Take a photo ID with you. If you are in isolation or quarantine, you give someone permission to pick up your prescription on your behalf through the secure patient portal. Students must present a valid university card upon arrival. The Health Center accepts private insurance and participates in many insurance plans. Students must carry their insurance card next to their university identity card. However, payment of the co-payments of the plan is expected at the time of the service. Any balance left unpaid by the insurance company will be sent to the person as a guarantor. We accept the corresponding insurance plan, private insurance, cash, cheque or credit cards.
