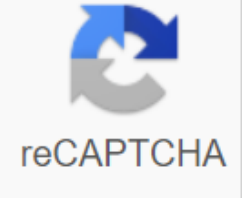

Mass transfusion is defined as transfusion of more than 10 units of blood within 24 hours or more than four units in one hour. Early resuscitation with blood and blood products in low ratios is recommended for patients with evidence of grade III and IV hemorrhage.
