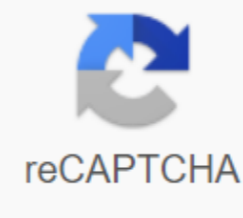

My Girlfriend and Childhood Friend Fight Too Much is a Japanese light novel series written by Yaji Yaji, with illustrations provided by Ruroo. SoftBank Creative has published fifteen novels since February 2011. There have been four manga adaptations and anime adaptations of A-1 Pictures aired from January to March 2013. The Eit Kido site enters a high school with the aim of graduating with signs high enough that he can get a scholarship to a medical school. Because his parents divorced, found new lovers and left him in the care of his aunt, he avoids anything to do with romance or love. One day, the no.1 beauty school, Masuzu Natsukawa, invites him to go home with her. He quickly makes it that Masuzu is up to something. It turns out that Masuzu is tired of being in the spotlight and receiving recognition on an almost everyday basis, so she invites her and Ayte to become a fake couple. Although Eita rejects, Maszu blackmails him to become her boyfriend only by name. News of the new couple quickly spreads throughout the school and Ait's childhood friend, Chiv Harusaki, who loves him, begins to rival Masuz for Eita's affections. Eit Kydo (季堂 Kydo Eita) Voiced by Junji Majima (CD drama), Ryota Asaka (anime) Eita is the main character who aspires to attend medical school after high school. He is very smart and always places at the top of school exams. He has a strong distrust of love and romance because of his parents divorce, finding new lovers, and abandoning him when he was in high school, thereby calling himself anti-romantic. His antipathy to romance also stems from the fact that it will interfere with his study. It turned out that during high school, he had teenage misconceptions and thought of himself as a Burning Fighting Fighter. However, the accident with Civ was forced to give up his delusions and decided to become a doctor. Although he has outgrown teenage misconceptions, he sometimes backs down if he becomes too emotional. Masuzu Natsukawa (夏川 真涼, Natsukawa Masuzu) Voiced by Chiwa Saito (drama CD), Yukari Tamura (anime) Masuzu is a friend of Eita. She is a school beauty who returned to Japan after spending nine years abroad. Like Eita, she hates romance and is tired of receiving (and rejecting) confessions every day. Masuzu uses Eita's high school notebook, filled with awkward notes and doodles, to blackmail him into pretending to be her boyfriend. She forms a club called the Maiden Society to fulfill her own life, where she learns how to become popular. When she's not with Aita, Masuzu presents a cold manner; but when she's with him, she's more sociable, mischievous and cunning: she likes to use words to trick him. Like Chiv, she's a terrible cook. Masuzu likes to quote scenes from JoJo's Bizarre Adventure. Eventually she falls in love with Eitu without actually realizing it, and becomes jealous when he interacts with other girls. Since she is the official friend of Eita, Chiv, Jimeka and Ai often join forces against her, fighting for him. Her family lives in Sweden, and her relationship with them, especially with her father, is complicated and has affected her twisted personality. Masuzu's father took her away from his mother so that people of his acquaintance with the highest social status would accept him. Because of this, however, she had to learn to act and present a false face to society, causing her to suffer from an identity crisis. Chiv Harusaki (春咲 千和, Harusaki Chiv) Voiced: Aki Toyosaki (CD drama), Chinatsu Akasaki (anime) Chiv is the best childhood friend of Eit. She is usually referred to as Chiwawa (chihuahua) by her friends because of her petite physique and a pair of two-headed ones that resemble puppy ears. She started attending the Kendo Club in elementary school, but had to drop out of school a year before she enrolled in school because of the serious injury she sustained in a car accident. This event is the reason that Eeta wants to pursue a medical career - so he help her fully recover from her injuries. She does not give up easily and constantly fights with Masuza for the affections of Eita. She loves to eat and especially loves meat, but she is a terrible cook. However, in light novels she begins to improve her cooking skills for Eita. She had romantic feelings for Eita for years, but was too shy to confess until Masuzu arrived in the picture. She finally confesses to Aite at the end of the fourth light novel, but is quickly interrupted by Masuza and other girls. She does not like to see how the girls get closer to Aita, but she quickly befriends them. Gimeka Akishino (秋篠 姫香, Akishino Gimeka) Voiced: Hisako Kanemoto Giteka is former girl of Eita, who has a one-sided love with him. Gimeka has teenage misconceptions, believing that in a previous life she was the Burning Princess of the Holy Dragon Lady of Dawn. After seeing Eita reveal some of his teenage misconceptions, she believes that Eita and she were a couple in her previous life. When He is not immersed in his delusions, He is very quiet and usually answers questions only with nodding. Other girls often call her a princess (姫, hime). Hearing Ai's friend's fake story, she calls Ai The Master of Love. Ai Fuyumi (冬海 愛衣, Fuyumi Ai) Voiced: Ai Ayano Ai is Iita's bride and a childhood friend whom he knew a year before meeting Ivo and who left ten years ago but recently returned. Ai considers herself one for Eita because she confessed to him when they were in kindergarten, and they even signed an impromptu marriage registration, forcing them to engage, even though Eita didn't understand the concept of marriage. Ai lied about being a guy in college and also holding a laptop like Eita. No one but Kaoru and Gimeki knows about it. She often has misconceptions about herself and Eit as a couple. As a member of the student disciplinary committee, she tries to stop the activities of the club Chiv and Masuzu, but later decides to join the club to return Toe. Saeko Chirie (桐生 冴子, Kyrie Saeko) Voiced: Kaori Nazuka Saeko is Eita's aunt, with whom he has lived since his parents abandoned him. She works in a gaming company that makes mostly bisjogo games, is an expert with such games and always makes real-world analogies with them in relation to girls. She is a workaholic who can survive long periods of time without sleep. Despite their protests on the contrary, she immediately realized that Eita and Masuzu are not really a couple just on surveillance. She often gives Aeta advice on how to get along with girls, and even tells him how to separate from the other girls in case he chose one of them. Kaoru Asui (遊井 カオ, Asoi Kaoru) Voiced: Reisa Taneda Kaoru is a classmate of Eitha and his best friend, who sat next to him before changing places. Kaoru knows Ai from elementary and calls it A-chan. Although originally thought to be a man, it hinted in the story that Kaoru may actually be a girl, or in love with Ait. In the light novels, it is shown that Kaoru is actually a girl. Mana Natsukawa (夏川 真那, Natsukawa Mana) Voiced: Nao Toyama Mana is the younger sister of Masuzu, who has seen with a bodyguard at all times. She wants her older sister to return to Sweden, and even reports her activities to her father. Although her relationship with Masuza is complicated, she seems to love her sister. Miharuru Misora (美空 美晴, Misora Miharuru) Miharuru is a character exclusive to the spin-off manga Ore no Kanojo to Osananajimi ga Shuraba Sugiru-H. She is the daughter of a high school principal who tries to capture Agatha's affections. It later emerged that she had a childhood friend named Keita Fujinami, whom she considered a brother and possibly more. However, when Keita confessed to Masuz, she (also) rejected him cruelly. The refusal affected him until he moved to another school, leaving the depressed Mihara behind. When she heard that Masuzu now has a boyfriend, she wants revenge on Keita by stealing Eita from Masuz, unaware that Masuzu and Eita are not actually dating. After learning of Mihar's motives, Eita confronts her about her feelings for Kate, and she refuses revenge. She later moved to Tokyo in the hope of reuniting with Keita; Masuzu gives her an envelope filled with her rejected love letters to encourage her and a questionnaire to join their club when she returns. Media Light novels Ore no Canojo in Osananajimi ga Shuraba Sugiru began as the light novel series, written by Yaji Yaji, with illustrations by Ruroo. The series was written in seven volumes of the tank published between December 15, 2011 and April 22, 2014. The four-board comic book manga, illustrated by Marimo and named Ore No osanajimi ga Shuraba Sugiru 4-com (俺彼女と幼なじみが修羅場すぎる4コマ), was published in the magazine Square Enix Young Gangan between October 21, 2011 and April 5, 2013. The series was composed in two volumes of the tank, released on July 14, 2012 and January 12, 2013.
