

INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY HOUSING PROVIDERS DISCOUNT TICKET PROGRAM

It's a basic human right.

The World Indigenous Housing Conference is the principal conference to provide a platform for leaders in housing, health, education and related services from around the world to come together.

Delegates representing Indigenous leaders, government, industry and academia will meet in May 2019 on Australia's world-famous Gold Coast. They will share experiences, explore opportunities and innovative solutions, work to improve access to adequate housing and related services for the world's Indigenous people.

The Conference is being facilitated through the National Congress of Australia's First Peoples. They are now calling for nominations from Indigenous Community Housing Providers who would like to participate in the event at a special discounted rate. Limited to 100 tickets globally.

CRITERIA:

1. General Principle

The Indigenous Community Housing Provider Discount Ticket Program (The Program) is designed to provide financial support to individuals and organisations who are intimately related and specialised in the Indigenous housing sector but are experiencing financial difficulties in attending the 2019 World Indigenous Housing Conference (2019 WIHC). The 2019 WIHC seeks to encourage all organisations, particularly small ones and their representatives to attend the Conference, maintaining relatively open access to the intellectual platform provided to enable housing experts to share their best practices and experience.

The 2019 WIHC applies globally to all qualified organisations and representatives applying for a discounted Conference ticket. The discounted tickets are limited to 100 tickets globally.

2. The Nominee Must Meet the Following Criteria

- 2.1 The Nominee must:
 - a. be of Indigenous descent;
 - identify as an Indigenous person (e.g. Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander, Maori, Native American etc):
 - c. be accepted as an Indigenous person by the Indigenous community in which they live:
 - have worked in an Indigenous housing sector for at least 2 years of housing or housing related services and support.
 - e. be attending on behalf of or related to an Indigenous Organisation (see Section 3 for definition) specialising in the Indigenous housing sector; and
 - f. be limited by financial constraints in purchasing a conference ticket.
- 2.2 More than one person may be nominated per Indigenous Organisation however if there is a large demand for discounted tickets, only one person may be selected from each Indigenous Organisation nomination.

3. Definition - The Indigenous Organisation

- 3.1 The Indigenous Organisation, for the purpose of the Program, must:
 - a. operate on a not-for-profit basis;
 - b. operate specifically in the Indigenous housing sector for at least 5 years;
 - c. have at least 51% of its members being of an Indigenous background;
 - d. have at least 51% of its governing board being of an Indigenous background; and
 - e. should own or manage no less than 10 rental properties.

4. Discounted Ticket Price

- i. The organisation will need to provide an explanation or details regarding the reasons for not being able to resource the attendance of their nominated person.
- ii. Once the application has been received and the nominee meets the criteria, a discounted ticket price may be offered to the nominee.
