On the one hand, you may fear that it will turn your child into a hunched zombie, or that she will be constantly distracted, or that it will mess with her brain in ways we don't yet know about, or any other bullet point on the list is not good, very bad potential consequences. On the other hand, well, sometimes you have to contact the baby. You want to know if softball practice is late or whether it's still waiting at the bus stop. Or maybe she left for two weeks for camp and you just want to check in. We've offered the idea of giving your kid an old flip phone (pink Motorola Razr, I missed you!), and a whole crop of basic cell phones has recently hit the market, but now an even more minimalist option. Relay, a new device made by Republic Wireless, is now called an anti-smartphone for children because of everything it doesn't have. A palm-sized gadget with only one main button, it works like a walkie-talkie (yes, your family can claim to be a modern cast of Stranger Things), although it connects via Wi-Fi and 4G LTE, so you can use it anywhere you'd use your cell phone. No screens, no text messages, no phone numbers to punch through. And since it's designed for children between the ages of six and 11 (as well as the elderly), it's able to weather some good drops and spills. My daughter Maggie is five and a half years old, so she's a little younger than the target age, but we're having fun with them. As a parent, you can also talk to your child through the Relay app on your smartphone (iOS, Android and Microsoft). The data is never stored, and Republic Wireless has worked with common sense to make sure the device is safe and secure. Kids can now ask Alexa to tell them a knock-knocking joke on their Device. I know. hesitation around digital monitoring of children, and I have reservations, too, especially for older children trying to develop independence. One day, with permission, I sent my daughter to school with him. As soon as she settled down, I started getting messages. Hi mom. Hey, Maggie. I'm in the art hall. Ok. Now I play with blocks. Ok. Now I'm outside. Ok. Jenny wants to say hello. Hey, Jenny. HIIIIIIIIIIIIII Hello. Hey, Michelle. This is Miss Melina. It's so neat! Does it work by satellite? Ok. Okay, here's Maggie again. Hi mom. Hey, Maggie. Part of me wanted to say, Just write to me!, but then I remembered that she had no way to do it, and she couldn't read or write yet. (If you have an app, your child can hold the volume key on the Relay device and a push notification will appear on your smartphone that alerts you to switch to the relay talk app.) Also, since it's so small, it's easy for kids to lose a device, although the company is developing a clip and arm strap for sale separately. Battery life is not great, it lasts more than a day, but you have to charge it every night. And Republic Wireless is constantly updating the relay to add more features. There's already a tool that distorts your voice, and soon there will be games, streaming music, and a kid friendly AI assistant. It may be sellers for some, but the purist in me really wants a product that has none of this. I appreciate the fact that the relay is at the most basic level-walkie-talkie that you can take anywhere. And yet just for that, the relay is expensive. A starter package of two relays costs \$149, plus a \$6.99 monthly plan. So, in many ways, it makes sense for the company to continue to make the relay more exciting with flashy additions. But at the same time, the more features it adds, the closer it gets to the stuff of parents wanted for his children, first of all: a smartphone. The headphone jack at the top of the talkie goki allows children to connect headphones or a headset for private or quiet conversations. LCD is illuminated and displays battery life remaining, the channel of operation, and the power of the signal. Sizerwise, it's great for small hands. Textured ribs on the sides prevents the radio from slipping out of hands and pockets, and they are convenient for the village of all ages. The only problem is the anemic instructions of the flyers. Each receiver is ergonomically designed to fit comfortably in the hands of children aged three years and up. The large central button works push-to-talk, and it's smooth for pressing and releasing for kids of all ages. There are 22 channels available and the sound is balanced and clear. The backlit display shows the strength of the signal, the channel number and the battery level. The included belt clips give kids a way to attach radios to belts, backpacks, and other bags. Additional services include VOX, 38 privacy codes, 10 call tones and keyboard lock. If there is something to complain about, it is the number of buttons. For older children, it's be a problem. The instructions with this model leave much to be desired. It's a one-size-fits-all guide for all the radio stations That Retevis produces. You will need to work out a lot of things that don't apply to this set to find the information you need to get up and running. Once you've done that, it's a reliable set of two-way radio that both kids and adults will enjoy in the backyard, on neighborhood adventures, or around the house.
