This Sunday is mission Sunday and the gospel for this year's mission Sunday is taken from the discourse of Jesus at the Last Supper. Jesus prays that as the Father has sent him into the world, he sends his disciples into the world. He prays that they may be consecrated in truth and prays "With me in them and they in me, may they be completely one and the world will realise that it was you who sent me and that I have loved them as much as you loved me"
