Job Carr moved west because a transcontinental railroad was being built from the Great Lakes to Puget Sound. Like other pioneers, he wanted to make a better life for himself. He believed that the railroad would bring opportunity. He just needed to find the place where the railroad would end.

In July 1873, the Northern Pacific Railroad chose Commencement Bay as the terminus of its transcontinental line. The first NPRR train arrived in Tacoma in December 1873.
