

### My Testimony

My mother started taking me to Sunday School when I was in Primary two, hoping that it would help my English. When I was in my tweens, I attended worship services with my



elder brother. I was baptised on 10th February 1962 when I was in Secondary School.

From that day on, I did not miss a single service or activity of the Lord's church. Four years later, I entered full-time ministry. The majority of my years were spent in the ministry, during the difficult, but exciting formative years of the church in Singapore.

With the experience of six decades and benefit of God's word all these years, I want to pass on as my legacy these three lessons and their inherent blessings.

#### 1. Be Open to God's Call

The apostle Paul tells us in his letter to the Ephesians that we are saved by Grace through faith. Then with the same breath, he continues in Ephesians 2:10 that "we are His workmanship created in Christ Jesus for good works which God afore prepared that we should walk in them."

If we are children of God, no matter what we are doing, God has planned some good works for us to do. I can only think of one thing more terrible than using up our life and missing God's will - to know God's will and willfully disregard it.

### 2. Lead Your Family Under God

More than ever, the church needs to help model the way for our families. I love Joshua and it excites me to hear him say, "but as for me and my house, we will serve Jehovah." (Joshua 24:15).

#### 3. Make Spiritual Goals Annually

As long as we are alive, we grow. The moment we stop growing, we become old. The apostle writes to the Philippians 3:14, "I press on toward the goal unto the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus." Draw nearer to the Lord each and every day. As the year ends, renew your spiritual goals annually, especially bringing your parents to Christ.



Matthew 16:18 Jesus said, "I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it"






# 1. Jesus is the founder of the church



Are you willing to devote your life to the church, and even die for it, like the apostles did?


