I. Purpose of the program

Dr. Gavin Wittje has designed the following English enhancement program specifically for talented middle school students with the following overall goals:

- 1. Increasing students' skills in English vocabulary, reading, writing, and grammar
- 2. Practicing SSAT/ISEE/HSPT for High School Entrance Exams or just for enhancing your test skills
- 3. Getting an early start in PSAT/SAT tests and college preparations
- 4. Heightening students' capability to understand and enjoy life
- 5. Deepening students' all-round knowledge about humanities and social sciences
- 6. Enriching students' educational experience overall
