THE CLUB'S FUTURE

Nominees Please

Are you interested in helping to define the future of our Club? If so, please consider running for a position on the Board of Directors or as an Executive Officer. The Search Committee of the Club is seeking members to fill these critical positions. Currently, there are three Board seats available and all Executive positions available. Executive office seats are an annual occurrence while (3) Board seats are a triennial occurrence.

The Club has survived for decades because members elected to office have the heart of the Club in mind and are not self-serving. They have a Fiduciary responsibility to the Club and are eager to excel in that role. These are the Club Members the Search Committee (see below) is pursuing for nomination in November. Specifically, the Board could benefit by candidates that are knowledgeable in finances, marketing and sales, human resources, and event planning and food service industries. These are just a few of the skills that will support the Club's current and future viability for generations to come.

Serving on the Board or as an Executive Officer requires dedication and a strong commitment of time. While it is the responsibility of the Members to participate in Club activities--it's what keeps the Club functioning—it is the responsibility of the Executive Officers and Board members to maintain current interest of its membership by providing events of interest to all age groups, and to identify new activities and methods for member recruitment and retention.

The Club is in a transitionary stage in that many current members have close ties with Italian immigrants (close relatives or personal). The next and future Italian generations have experiences that are multi-cultural. The Club needs to recognize this variation and respond to guarantee the future of the Club and its Italian Heritage.

Please give serious consideration to and identification of Members (or yourself) that fit the above criteria. Inform the Search Committee that comprises Jerry Podesta, Pat Dianda, Maureen Freschet, and Joy Morriss of your nomination intent. The Committee will then present these nominees to the Board and at the November General Dinner Meeting. Additional nominees can be presented from The Floor at that meeting. Thank you in advance for your active participation and quick response.

Revision - By-Laws

Per ARTICLE IX of the By-laws, you are formally being notified that the following revisions (In Blue) to the By-Laws are to be voted on, at the October 14, 2025 General Dinner meeting

Article V

Section 2. All Officers and Directors for the Corporation shall be a least twenty-one (21) years of age and shall have been a member in good standing in the Corporation for at least three years preceding the date of the election. The President of the Corporation shall be a citizen of the United States.

Section 4. The Officers and Directors of the Corporation shall be elected by the members of the Corporation at the Annual Meeting of the corporation on the second Tuesday of December of each year by secret ballot. Nomination of Officers and Directors of the Corporation shall be held on the second Tuesday of November of each year and newly elected Officers and Directors shall assume the responsibilities of the office to which they were elected on January 1, each year.

Section 6. It shall be the duty of the President, under the direction of the Board of Directors, to preside at all meetings of the Corporation and the Board of Directors to ensure that the By-Laws, policies and adopted motions approved by the Corporation are strictly enforced. The President at the November General meeting or special meeting set by the Board of Directors, shall make a report of all accounts and general activities of the Corporation during the current year. The President shall appoint all standing committees by, and with the advice, consent and approval of the Board of Directors, and shall be ex-officio, a member of the same. The President shall sign jointly with the Secretary and Treasurer all contracts, bonds and other instruments in writing.—The President is authorized to sign jointly with the Treasurer and Secretary all checks and warrants for the disbursements of the funds of the Corporation. The President shall not be entitled to vote upon any measure presented at meeting of the Corporation, except in case of a tie. The President shall, however, have the right to vote upon the election of officers.

In the absence or inability of the President to act, the Vice President shall perform all the duties of the President. If the President and Vice President shall be absent from any meeting, the Secretary shall call the meeting to order and a temporary chairman shall be chosen.

Minimum Requirement for Nomination to the Position of President: Nominee must have served as an Executive Officer (Vice President, Secretary or Treasurer), or a director for at least one year
