The Archetypal Language Model: A modern cosmology Rob Hindmarch

Archetypes, whether viewed from an astrological, Jungian or metaphysical perspective, have a profound influence on human experience. Archetypes are universal patterns that find expression in the human psyche as ideas and feelings and have been attributed as first causes in the development of the arts, religion, and science. The Archetypal Language Model links archetypes and geometry with concepts and vocabulary providing a functional tool for understanding human experience as it is expressed upon the chain of being.

The talk will focus on the relationship of archetypal crosses to solving human issues on a mythological, psychological, and sociological level.

Rob Hindmarch is an archetypal researcher and counselor. He is a long time member of an ancient mystical order and a teacher in its research academy. He is currently developing a model of human consciousness that shows that the psyche is patterned on underlying cosmic principles and that human experience can be understood through the metaphors and language corresponding to these principles.
