

INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

regarding the issue of Alexander Paramonov being the King of Kings and related issues

General Information about Alexander Nikolaevich Paramonov

There is a man alive today *who has the title King of Kings*.¹ Also, he states that he is the Son of God, and that he controls the financial system of the entire world.² His name is Alexander Nikolaevich Paramonov. He is Russian and does not speak English. He is the owner and manager of the largest financial fund in the world which is backed by the largest collection of physical gold in the world. The name of that fund is: the *Sovereign International Treasury Monetary One* (“M1”) (www.ruskazna.su/en). He is not using that fund to make more money (or at least that is not his primary purpose). Rather, he is working to create an excellent and beautiful new world for us. He is also working to bring to justice and remove from power the “parasites,” the insane enemies of mankind who presently control our world. He says that the parasites’ only tool for controlling us is their control of the financial system. Thus, he is creating a new, gold backed money system which they cannot control. This new financial system will replace the old, corrupt, fiat money system.

The Sunrise Program

Also, Alexander Paramonov has initiated what he calls the *Sunrise Program*. With this program any group of people anywhere in the world, can apply to M1 to open a “cooperative” bank branch, which will deal in gold backed money. He says that it is easy to start such a bank and that M1 will supply all the forms, software and guidance that will be needed. M1 will also provide funding for the new bank.³ One such bank branch has already been created in the nation of Slovakia (www.spdr.sk/en/). *Finally, here is a practical and effective way for patriots and upstanding humans to fight back against the deranged and evil powers that be which are perverting and destroying human civilization.* Joining or creating one of these “cooperative” banks also presents an excellent opportunity for people to do much good by helping to usher in the new Golden Era.

Is Alexander Nikolaevich Paramonov the Christ?

A key, important and extraordinary question which may arise in the reader’s mind as he reviews material pertaining to Alexander Paramonov (on www.firstamendmentcafe.com and/or elsewhere) is that of whether or not he is Christ. The notion that Christ is here on earth in the

flesh now, and that most people are not aware of it, may seem too incredible to believe. But I urge the reader to keep an open mind on this.

There are some points which support that conclusion and other points which seem to go against it. After considering these points, I have concluded that, incredibly, Alexander Nikolaevich Paramonov is, in fact, the Christ who has returned. In the discussion below I present some of these pro and con points, and my analysis of many of them. Here is my discussion and analysis of this issue:

Some reasons why one could conclude that Alexander Paramonov is Christ

Let's start off by considering some of the reasons why one would think or argue that Alexander Paramonov is the Christ:

- He has the title "King of Kings," which generally refers to Christ.⁴
- He has made a number of extraordinary claims about himself, including but not limited to his claims that he is the King of Kings, that he is the Son of God, and that he controls the entire world financial system, and yet he does not seem to have faltered nor suffered significant adverse consequences. When a person starts making extraordinary and lofty claims about himself – and this may apply especially to spiritual claims – if those claims are not true there is a tendency (based on my observations) for life to humble that person, and to expose him as a hypocrite, as one who is making false claims, or as being corrupt in one way or another.⁵ But this has not happened to Alexander Paramonov (at least not so far). This, I would argue, is an indication that the lofty spiritual claims about him are actually true.
- The fact that he has been able to oppose the parasites, as he has been doing, without getting killed by them is also noteworthy. It implies that he has divine protection.
- He speaks very knowledgeably (at least in my view) about spiritual issues.
- He owns and manages the largest financial fund in the world (as stated above) and has publicly offered to provide financing to assist entire countries, and to fund beneficial projects throughout the world, and even to help individuals who are in need

But, as discussed below, prophecies indicate that this present time is the time of the Antichrist and therefore it may be that Alexander Paramonov must lay low for now. And if his spiritual claims had been attested to by one or more high profile spiritual authorities (instead of just himself), such as maybe the pope, that might have made it too obvious that he was Christ and then the time of the Antichrist could have been negated or undermined, which is not what is supposed to happen.

of financial assistance.

- He also has started tackling and solving a huge and fundamental problem of the world. He has introduced a gold backed money system to replace the current fiat money system, something which will take away the power and control of the sick and evil parasites who rule us and have been destroying humanity. This is a major step towards freeing humanity from the control of those parasites.
- He has created the *Sunrise Program* which enables groups of people anywhere in the world to apply to create “cooperative” banks which use the new gold backed money system.

These are impressive accomplishments and attributes. Not a bad start for someone taking on the role of Savior of the World. So there is a basis, at least based on an initial examination, for arguing that Alexander Nikolaevich Paramonov is Christ.

Possible objections to the notion that Alexander Paramonov is Christ

Now let's examine some of the objections that might be raised to the conclusion that Alexander Paramonov is Christ.

Alexander Paramonov does not state that he is Christ

While Alexander Paramonov does claim the title King of Kings, he does not anywhere state that he is Christ (as far as I know), and in several instances he even uses the term Christ in the third person.⁶

My response – based on my opinions (and my understanding of Christian prophecies) and not on what Alexander Paramonov has stated – is that although he is presently in the world and working to change it for the better, he is intentionally laying somewhat low for now. He will not openly refer to himself as “Christ” yet because the time of the Antichrist is commencing now, and people need to show that they can make the right choice and NOT submit to the Antichrist or his programs. They must make that choice on their own, without being explicitly given the answer by the King of Kings.

Alexander Paramonov seems different in some ways from the Christ we read about in the Bible

Another objection that might be raised (after one reviews videos of Alexander Paramonov and/or documents that he wrote) is that he does not seem to act like the Christ we read about in the Bible, at least in some ways. He is not performing overt miracles (as far as I know), and he spends considerable time discussing the details of the world financial system and other seemingly mundane topics. He also highly praises the USSR (and the Slavic people), which might be difficult for Americans and Europeans to understand since we have been taught very negative things about that nation. In short, he might seem to be overly preoccupied with

relatively mundane issues rather than more spiritual ones, and some of his ideas might seem questionable.

My response – based on my opinions and not what Alexander Paramonov has stated – is: He may be refraining from performing miracles because he may need to lay low at this time, as discussed above. (Or it may not be necessary to perform miracles at this time, as this is a different era from the one that was present when he was previously here.) He is discussing the seemingly mundane topic of world finances because that is what needs to be addressed at this point in history to break the grip of the parasites on this world. It may be that he praises the USSR (and the Slavic people) because there is, in fact, a special connection between that nation and God (which is what he states).

Bible passages state that when Christ returns it will be upon clouds in the sky

Revelations 1:7, Matthew 26:64 and Acts 1:9-11 all seem to indicate that when Christ returns it will be upon clouds in the sky. These passages seem inconsistent with the notion that the Christ is living amongst us in human form today, managing a financial fund, without many people knowing of him.

My response: I don't know for sure how to reconcile those Bible passages with notion that Alexander Paramonov is the Christ, but one possibility is the following:

He is laying somewhat low for now (as discussed above). I do not expect him to become very widely known at this time, as it is now the time of the Antichrist.

But there is an Islamic prophecy which predicts that Christ will appear and descend and kill the Antichrist. (See: Sahih Muslim Book 41, Hadith Number 6924. Also, 2nd Thessalonians 2:8 indicates that Christ will kill the Antichrist.) It stands to reason that this event should occur at the end of the Great Tribulation (during the Battle of Armageddon). It could be that at that dramatic point in time the human population in general will suddenly and for the first time see Christ as Christ, coming on clouds in the sky (even though he will have previously been living on earth somewhat quietly).

The Bible says that there will be false prophets and false Christs and that if someone claims that Christ has returned one should not believe it.

Matthew 24:23-27 (KJV) says:

“²³Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here *is* Christ, or there; believe *it* not. ²⁴For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if *it were* possible, they shall deceive the very elect. ²⁵Behold, I have told you before. ²⁶Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, *he is* in the secret chambers; believe *it* not. ²⁷For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.”

My response: Similar to my response in the previous section, I am not certain how to explain the discrepancy between this quotation from the Bible and the notion that Alexander Paramonov is Christ. But the following points provide a response which may be correct:

Similar to what was discussed above, Alexander Paramonov may be living on earth and laying somewhat low at this time, because it is the time of the Antichrist. And when he finally slays the Antichrist at the end of the Great Tribulation and makes his first “official” appearance as Christ it may be that at that dramatic moment everyone will see him in glorious form and it will be like lightning shining everywhere. And it may be that only relatively few people will be able to recognize him prior to that point in time, even though he will have been living on earth for some time prior to that.

The above quoted passage from Matthew warns of false prophets and that one should not follow them, and this (I think) is surely good advice. But that does not eliminate the possibility that Christ is nonetheless among us at this time, doing crucial work to orchestrate the direction of human events, and that a limited number of people will be able to recognize him earlier on.

With all of that said, I do acknowledge that some of the language in Matthew 24:23-27 does seem to preclude the notion that Alexander Paramonov is Christ. But nonetheless, when I consider:

- that he has the title King of Kings and states that he is the Son of God;
- how he is taking major steps towards saving the entire planet from the grip of the evil, Satanic powers that be (i.e., his is introducing a gold backed financial system);
- the wisdom with which (I believe) he speaks, both about current events and regarding prophesies about the End Times⁷;
- that I do not see any corruption, falsehoods or hypocrisy (to speak of) in his speech or conduct or that of his organizations; and
- that it is evident that his overall aim seems to be just to help humanity, bring the enemies of humanity to justice, and bring about a much better world;

my conclusion is that he must be the Christ (despite the language of Matthew 24:23-27).

And remember that when Christ was here the last time (the first time) he himself violated rules from the scriptures in some instances.⁸ In light of that, I urge the reader to really consider the evidence on this important issue with an open mind. Things do not always happen as we expect them to, and they do not always have the nature that we assume they do. I urge you, the reader, to listen to Alexander Paramonov’s interviews (see some of his videos on www.firstamendmentcafe.com and elsewhere) and review some of the documents written by him and to just consider the facts about him and the noble, extraordinary and world-changing work that he is doing, and then to come to your own conclusion on this important point (the question of whether or not he is Christ) based on your own observations, honest analysis, and genuine, internal sense of what is true.

And if you choose not to believe that Alexander Paramonov is the Christ, remember that he himself has not made that claim (although he has come close to doing so). It is I who am stating that I believe him to be Christ. So do not hold it against him if you do not believe this. He cannot be accused of falsely claiming to be Christ because he has not made such a claim.

Even if the reader doubts that Alexander Paramonov is Christ the reader is still left with the fact that he is an honorable and upstanding man who is taking extraordinary steps to fight against the parasites who control our society, the powers that be, and for the benefit of humanity. He is working to create a gold based money system which the parasites cannot control and he is inviting citizens throughout the world to join his efforts by opening “cooperative” bank branches (through the *Sunrise Program*) which deal in gold backed money; or by joining such a bank which is already in operation. It is easy to see, and many people would agree, that this is a very good idea and a plan which could greatly benefit humanity. So whether or not one believes that Alexander Paramonov is Christ, we should all work together, with his M1 fund, to create a gold backed money system which will free us all from the insane enemies of mankind who are controlling and destroying humanity.

What to do if one does believe that Alexander Paramonov is Christ

On the other hand, if one has concluded that Alexander Parmonov is Christ, what should one do? Well, I would think that one should make it a point to review his videos and written statements. I would think that one would have all the more incentive to try to work with the *Sunrise Program* and start a “cooperative” bank. And I would think that one should take very seriously Alexander Paramonov’s warning that the End Times have started, as well as his warning that (as I understand it) those who have not clearly established and shown their highest spiritual status, their worthiness to enter the Kingdom of God, *have only until 2026 to do so.*⁹ According to prophecy, conditions for humanity are soon going to get far worse than they are now and the pressure to capitulate to the Antichrist will be great. One should earnestly prepare.¹⁰ I also urge and ask the reader to spread the word about the information discussed on the www.firstamendmentcafe.com website far and wide, including (but not limited to) by bringing it to the attention of leaders of nations around the world.

Conclusion

There is reason to believe that Alexander Paramonov is Christ. If he is Christ, as I think he is, it is incredibly good news and we are very fortunate to have him among us. But whether or not one believes this to be the case we can and should all work together, with the *Sunrise Program*, to create a gold backed money system which will free humanity from the sick and evil parasites who control it. And let’s spread the word about these issues.
