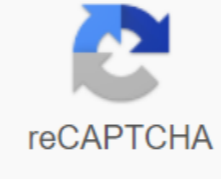

Free pdf to doc converter app

Windows only: There are many, many tools to convert Microsoft Word files into PDF documents, including built-in recent office suites, but what about the opposite? The Free PDF for Word Doc Converter is a small program that solves a big headache for some office and document workers. Download the PDF, choose how you want to export the file, including images, shapes, and text layout features, and create a conversion button. My own tests have found, like others, that some pretty large Word files can come out, especially if you have images and graphics built in, but for standard text only document, the free tool gets most of the text and layout right.
