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2025 Summer Session Accelerated English Class Syllabus A 11-week summer session; one meeting per week

Sunday 5pm-7pm from 6/3-8/12/2025

I. Theme

The theme this semester will be the supernatural: ghosts and witches. In Western literarature, ghosts have to do with unresolved trauma and the recurrence of difficult memories. Witches are even more interesting. Traditionally, they represent the dark side of the feminine: malignant, seductive forces, castraters of men and eaters of children (Hansel and Gretel, Medea, Macbeth). But in recent years, feminism has worked to redeem this term and to expose the abuse that rebellious women were forced to suffer under patriarchy.

II. Purpose of the program

Dr. Gavin Wittje has designed the following English enhancement program specifically for talented 8th grade and high school students with the following overall goals:

- 1. Increasing students' skills in English vocabulary, reading, writing, and grammar
- 2. Practice ACT for enhancing your test skills
- 3. Getting an early start in PSAT/SAT tests and college preparations
- 4. Heighten students' capability to understand and enjoy life
- 5. Deepen students' all-round knowledge about humanities and social sciences
- 6. Enriching students' educational experience overall
