## Harrison Wrestling Registration

By becoming a member of the Harrison HS Wrestling Program, you are helping to promote and support the sport of wrestling, our wrestlers, wrestlerettes, and coaching staff. The registration fee is used to help meet the program's expenses throughout the season. Additional fundraising activities are planned throughout the year and are necessary to meet the budget. **Registration Fee: Due by October 25th** Wrestlers - \$350 & Wrestlerette \$200 (includes shorts, athletic shirt). Parents automatically become members of the Booster Organization by enrolling their child.

**Fundraising Deposit: Due by October 25th** \$200 Check Post Dated February 19th 2021 made out to HHWBC or Harrison High Wrestling Booster Club

**Refund Policy**- 50% refund by November 10th,2021

## Team Policies

On the Harrison High School Wrestling Team, we will follow the rules set forth by the Cobb County School District in the “*Code of Conduct*.” Each violation will be evaluated on an individual basis and will be subject to the penalties of the school district, extra conditioning, and/or suspension from participation in practices and/or competitions. In order to be reinstated in full on the Harrison High School Wrestling Team, the imposed penalties, extra conditioning, and/or suspension must be completed.

**The following violations may be cause for suspension or dismissal from the team:**

1. Use of illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco (tobacco-like substances, i.e. vaping)
2. Missing practice including Holiday practices (unless excused by a Harrison High School Wrestling Coach)
3. Cutting school or classes
4. Acting in an unsportsmanlike manner when representing Harrison High School
5. Any act at school or away from school which results in disciplinary action by the school administration
6. Leaving school without letting a Harrison High School Wrestling Coach know that you will not be at practice (family emergency, doctor’s appointment, etc.)
7. Violating curfew (state mandated or team mandated)
8. Any act at school or away from school which, in the opinion of the coaches and administration, reflects in a negative manner on the wrestling team or Harrison athletic program

# **FUNDRAISING - REQUIRED**

**Car Washes:** All athletes are required to participate in car wash opportunities as much as possible.

**Stadium Clean-Up:** Football stadium Cleanup. Athletes participate in football stadium cleanup after home games. Must confirm with Coach Crocker no later than the morning of the game to have the athlete's name added to the list and free admission to the game. This volunteer opportunity goes towards repayment to school for new wrestling mats.

## **What is a Wrestlerette?**

Definition: A wrestlerette is a manager, statistician, scorekeeper, organizer, coach's assistant, inventory control personnel, promoter of the sport of wrestling, school-spirited individual, and the list goes on.....

### **Selection Process**

To become a Harrison wrestlerette, one must participate in a week-long clinic, take a wrestling rules test (and score an 85% or better), sign a commitment statement, and become a member of the Takedown Club. (100% membership in the Takedown Club is our goal.)

### **Scorekeeping and Statistics**

The Wrestlerettes keep accurate records of individual matches and enter the statistics onto the computer for historical purposes and awards. Accuracy is the key and wrestlerettes are known for their abilities and have been the official scorekeepers at major tournaments on our schedule, including the State tournament.

### **Managers**

The Harrison wrestlerettes have weekly Tuesday meetings as well as practice days when they clean, organize, inventory, and prepare for wrestling events. We will also practice scoring live wrestle-offs to be able to practice scoring and keeping time. Bulletin boards, promotional events, and spirit signs are also made during this time. Wrestlerettes work diligently to promote the team and enable the coaches to do their jobs.

### **Inventory Control**

Keeping track of locks, lockers, uniforms, tournament supplies are all part of the job and it is NO easy task.

### **School Spirit and P.R.**

Wrestlerettes are involved in the school in many other arenas and use those opportunities to promote the sport of wrestling. They promote the sport of wrestling in a positive way in all areas of the school and community and make signs and spirit bags for wrestlers who qualify for region and state. Wrestlerettes also decorate the houses of wrestlers who qualify for state.
