AASC Enrichment Classes Free of Charge!!

Dear Parents,

Our “AASC Enrichment Classes” will begin the week of Apr. 11. **This will be a three-week session. In some of the classes, attendance at each class is mandatory because each class builds on the prior week’s work. In those classes, if you miss a day, you will not be allowed to return to the enrichment class for the remainder of the session.** We know that potentially there is not room for everyone as these classes do have a limited class size. Please make note of the times and appropriate level of each activity. Enrichment classes are after school, **with the exception of Tessellations Stencil Art which is before school.**

SIGN-UP PROCEDURE

Classes will not be offered through a lottery system. Instead, parents shall just stop in the office, email, or call with their 2 choices and the child will be placed in one of the choices. This is not a 1st choice/ 2nd choice situation – just tell us your 2 choices and you will get into one of them. This is similar to the Math Night sign-up.

Playful Puppetry Mrs. Mitchell (grade K-5) Mondays 2:45-3:30

The students will make a basic puppet each week. Examples: a sock puppet, a tube puppet, a spoon puppet, etc. Students will then use real puppets and finger puppets to create mini stories/skits to share with the class. The puppet skits will be divided by age group K-2 and 3-5.

Health Mrs. Leal (grade 2-4) Mondays 2:45-3:30

Physical education plays a critical role in educating the whole student. Research supports the importance of movement in educating both mind and body. During the 3 weeks of health enrichment, students will have an opportunity to improve their strategizing and gross motor skills as they work both independently and on teams during physically challenging, yet FUN games.

Tessellations Stencil Art Ms. Slamowitz (grade K-5) Tuesdays 7:15AM-8:00AM

Tessellation stencil is tiling a piece of paper with one choice of an animal stencil. You will use the stencil and trace it and then pattern your paper with that same stencil. The stencils will attach to each other in a pattern. There will be no white paper left when the students finish coloring.

Mixed Media Self-Portrait Mrs. King (grade 1-5) Tuesdays 2:45-3:30

Students will create a canvas self-portrait using a variety of paints and pastels. They will decorate their masterpiece using a variety of embellishments.
