Welcome to L-Lab

At L-Lab, we believe children learn language the same way they learn everything else: through play. Our approach is different by design. Instead of drills and worksheets, we wrap language inside experiences children genuinely love. They pick up "stir" because they're actually stirring. They count down in Arabic because they just built an airplane. Language becomes the natural soundtrack to their day, not a subject on a schedule. This is the L-Lab way: when learning feels like play, children don't just memorize words.

L-Lab Summer Camp 2026 offers a full play-based immersion experience in both Spanish and Arabic, woven seamlessly into nine weeks of hands-on adventures spanning science, art, music, movement, and community. We nurture curious, confident, and compassionate learners, children who leave our program not just with new vocabulary, but with a broader sense of the world and their place in it. Whether your child is a complete beginner or already has some language background, they will be met exactly where they are and stretched joyfully forward.

Our Unique Dual Focus Approach

The heart of L-Lab is how we weave language, culture, and character together into a single seamless experience. Rather than treating language as a subject to be studied, we make it the world children move through each day. On Spanish days, your child might set a table, learn the etiquette behind a meal, and discover that "por favor" sounds different when you actually mean it. On Arabic days, they might navigate a market, practice the greetings that open doors, or share a recipe the way a family would at home. This is where social and emotional learning comes alive naturally. Kindness, patience, respect, and collaboration aren't lessons on a slide; they're practised in real moments, in real

interactions, across two real languages. Children don't just learn how to say "thank you." They understand why it matters, and in whose culture it matters most.

When language carries meaning, children don't just learn faster. They grow deeper.

Our instructors are skilled at reading the room. Beginners are scaffolded with visuals, gestures, and key vocabulary, while more experienced speakers are gently encouraged to use richer expression. Every child participates fully, regardless of where they start. Fridays bring the week together with reflection, field trips, and student showcases, a chance to celebrate how much ground has been covered.

A Day in the Life at L-Lab Summer Camp

The L-Lab day runs from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday, a rich, full day designed to keep children engaged, stimulated, and deeply immersed from first bell to last. No two days look exactly the same, but every day holds the same spirit: joyful learning, meaningful challenge, and the kind of fun that makes kids ask to come back tomorrow.

Mornings kick off with language-themed activities, conversations, games, and stories built around the week's topic. Language is woven naturally throughout the day so children absorb it without realizing they're studying it.

From there, the day moves into hands-on STEAM projects: building, experimenting, designing, and discovering. Outdoor time is built into every afternoon, because movement and fresh air are part of the learning too. Campers also practice public speaking, work on creative arts projects, and take time to wind down intentionally before the day closes.

Stay and Play Extended Care: Leadership & Sports (4:00PM - 6:00PM)

We know learning doesn't stop after 4PM. L-Lab offers Extended Care daily from 4:00 to 6:00 PM. But this is not just supervised downtime; it is a dedicated sports program that gives campers the chance to stay active, build new skills, and bond with their peers in a completely different way than the main camp day.

Over the course of our Leadership & Sports program, we expose campers to a variety of sports and athletic activities, such as: basketball, soccer, volleyball, and field games. The variety is intentional. We want every child to find something they love, and to experience the quiet satisfaction of getting better at something through practice and effort. Stay & Play is structured, coached, and genuinely fun — the perfect way to close out a full day of learning.

Nine Weeks of Adventure: Our Summer Themes

Every week at L-Lab is its own complete adventure. Each theme is carefully designed to weave language learning, STEAM exploration, creative expression, and cultural discovery into a single, unified experience. Children do not just switch between subjects — they live inside a world for an entire week, going deeper each day. Here is a glimpse at what is in store:

A Summer Camp Like No Other

At L-Lab we take pride in being a place where children want to linger and return. There are plenty of summer camps. There are language programs. There are STEAM enrichment courses. L-Lab is something different, a place where all of those things live together under one roof, in a community that genuinely knows your child. We know that no two children are the same, and we've built L-Lab around that belief. From our small camper-to-staff ratio, to flexible scheduling options, to built-in adaptations within every learning module, every decision we make is designed to ensure each child feels seen, supported, and set up to thrive.

Our staff are trained not just as educators, but as mentors, equipped with social and emotional learning techniques that help them meet each child exactly where they are. Whether your child is a natural performer or a quiet observer, an eager risk-taker or a careful thinker, there is a place for them at L-Lab.

Dual Language Immersion

Most camps touch on culture at the surface. At L-Lab, campers are not simply studying a language. They are living inside it. Beginners and advanced speakers are welcomed equally; our instructors adapt vocabulary, pacing, and complexity in real time so that every child is challenged and no child is lost.

Small Groups, Big Impact

We maintain a staff-to-camper ratio of up to 1:12, carefully calibrated by age group. That number is not just a statistic; it means your child gets seen, heard, and supported every single day. Instructors know their names, their strengths, and their hesitations. In a world of large programs and crowded classrooms, that kind of attention is rare. At L-Lab, it is standard.

Community Is Part of the Curriculum

Learning does not stop at our walls. Throughout the summer, campers visit museums, parks, pools, and cultural institutions, with activities tied directly to that week's theme. We also bring the community in: local artists, business owners, and community leaders visit the camp to share their stories, crafts, and expertise. Children leave L-Lab not just with language skills, but with a wider, richer understanding of the world they are growing into.

Tuition, Fees and Meals

We believe in transparent, straightforward pricing so families can plan with confidence. Here is everything you need to know.

Without Lunch or Snack:

Full-Time (8:00 am - 4:00 pm): \$259/week | \$59/day (Drop-In)

Part-Time (3 full days/week): \$169/week

Half-Day (8:00 am - 12:00 pm or 12:00 pm - 4:00 pm): \$39/day

Extended Care (4:00 pm - 6:00 pm): \$25/day | \$120/week (Minimum 3 students required for extended care)

With Lunch & Snack:

L-Lab provides lunch from local restaurants, along with an afternoon snack. Families will receive the finalized lunch menu before camp begins. Lunches feature kid-friendly options such as chicken or beef with rice, sandwiches, kabobs, pasta, and include a side of vegetables or fruit.

Lunch:

Through our partnership with local vendors committed to quality and freshness, families can opt into a daily lunch program and snack program at just \$12/day.

Every meal is fully halal, freshly prepared, and designed with kids in mind. Think warm, hearty plates of chicken, fragrant rice, roasted vegetables, and kabob, the kind of food that feels like a real meal, not an afterthought. The weekly menu will be shared with families in advance so your child knows what is coming and you can plan accordingly.

Families who prefer to send lunch from home are welcome to do so. We ask that all packed lunches and snacks remain nut-free out of respect for the safety of all campers.

Registration and Camp Policies

How to Register

Registration is completed using this link: <https://www.learnwithllab.com/summer-break-camp>. Spaces are intentionally limited to maintain our small-group sizes, so we encourage families to register early. If your preferred week is full, you can join the waitlist. When a spot opens, the first family on the list receives a 36-hour enrollment offer by email.

What to Bring Each Day

Pack your child for an active, hands-on day outdoors and in. They will need comfortable clothes and sneakers they do not mind getting a little dirty, a hat and sunscreen for outdoor time, a refillable water bottle, and a nut-free lunch and snacks if not signed up for the lunch program.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

We understand that plans change, and as a small, family-owned business, we want to support our families while also sustaining the program that serves them. All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to info@learnwithllab.com. The date and time your email is received determines the applicable refund.

A non-refundable application fee is required to secure your child's place in a camp session: \$50.

The supplies fee is also nonrefundable; the fee depends on the enrollment period: \$25 (0–2 weeks) | \$50 (2–4 weeks) | \$75 (4–6 weeks) | \$100 (6–8 weeks)

The full tuition is due one calendar week after the invoice is generated, or before the first day of your child's camp session, whichever comes first.

Transfers

Families may request to transfer their child to a different camp week up to 14 days before the scheduled start date, subject to availability.

Minimum Enrollment

L-Lab reserves the right to cancel or combine camp weeks if minimum enrollment is not met. In this case, families will be offered the option to transfer to another week or receive a full refund.

Additional Information

We are unable to provide refunds or credits for missed days, late arrivals, early withdrawal, or cancellations once a camp session has begun. In the event of extenuating circumstances, please contact us to discuss the possibility of a partial credit for a future program. We believe in working together to find solutions that support our families.

Good to Know Before You Enroll

Every family comes to us with a different set of questions, and we have found that the same few topics come up again and again. Rather than leave you to hunt for answers, here is everything we think a parent or guardian should know going into the summer.

Your Child Does Not Need to Know a Single Word in Arabic or Spanish

This is probably the question we hear most often, and the answer is always the same: not at all. L-Lab is designed for all levels, from children who have never heard a word of Arabic to those who grew up speaking Spanish at the dinner table. What makes our immersion model work is precisely that it does not require prior knowledge, it meets children exactly where they are and builds from there. Our instructors assess each camper informally in those first days and adjust vocabulary, pacing, and challenge level in real time. Beginners are scaffolded with visuals, gestures, and key phrases. More experienced speakers are able to express themselves more richly and engage in nuanced conversation. Language acquisition here happens through play, storytelling, cooking, building, and guided interaction, not through pressure or the anxiety of being called on unprepared. By the end of the summer, your child will surprise you. They always do.

Conversely, if your child has familiarity with either language, they will feel adequately challenged in our program. Our curriculum builds in adaptations for different language lessons and our teachers are trained to customize the challenge levels for each activity depending on each child's abilities.

How We Group Campers

Campers are grouped by age, and that structure is intentional. Children at different developmental stages learn differently, communicate differently, and need different things from the people around them. Grouping by age allows our instructors to tailor language instruction, project complexity, and group dynamics to each cohort's level. Younger campers might be building a model and narrating what they are doing in simple Spanish phrases; older campers might be debating in Arabic about which design works best and why. Both groups are fully immersed, fully engaged, and fully challenged, just in the ways that are right for where they are. Occasionally, enrollment numbers may mean that a given age group is smaller than expected, and in those cases we may blend two neighboring age groups together. When that happens, the intentionality doesn't disappear — it simply shifts. Our instructors thoughtfully design activities that create meaningful entry points for every camper in the room, ensuring that a seven-year-old and a nine-year-old working side by side are each getting an experience that meets them where they are, even as they share the same table.

Field Trips and Community Visitors

Learning at L-Lab does not stay inside four walls. Throughout the summer, campers venture out on field trips to museums, parks, pools, and cultural institutions, each outing chosen to connect directly with that week's theme, so the experience has context, and the context has meaning. Families always receive advance communication with complete details: where, when, how they will get there, and any required permission forms to return.

We also bring the world to camp. Local artists, business owners, and community leaders visit throughout the summer to share their work, their stories, and their expertise with our campers in person. These in-house visits are some of the most memorable moments of the summer, the kind that children talk about on the car ride home and again at the dinner table.

Dietary Needs and the Lunch Program

All meals through our vendor lunch program are fully halal, freshly prepared, and menus are shared with families in advance. If your child has specific allergies or dietary needs, please contact us directly before the summer

begins. We would rather have that conversation early and figure out the right solution together. Families who prefer to send lunch from home are always welcome to do so. Our only request is that packed lunches remain nut-free to ensure the safety of all campers.

Attending for Part of the Summer

Families can register for a single week, a stretch of weeks, or the full nine-week summer, whatever fits your schedule and your child's needs. Each week at L-Lab is designed to stand on its own as a complete, satisfying experience, so there is no requirement to attend consecutively, and no sense of being behind if your child joins mid-summer. That said, children who return week after week benefit enormously from the cumulative effect of language exposure. Words that were brand new in Week 1 become familiar by Week 4 and second-nature by Week 8. The friendships deepen, too. If your schedule allows for more, we think your child will feel the difference.
