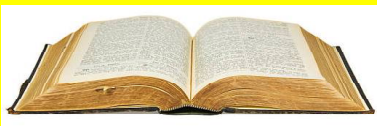

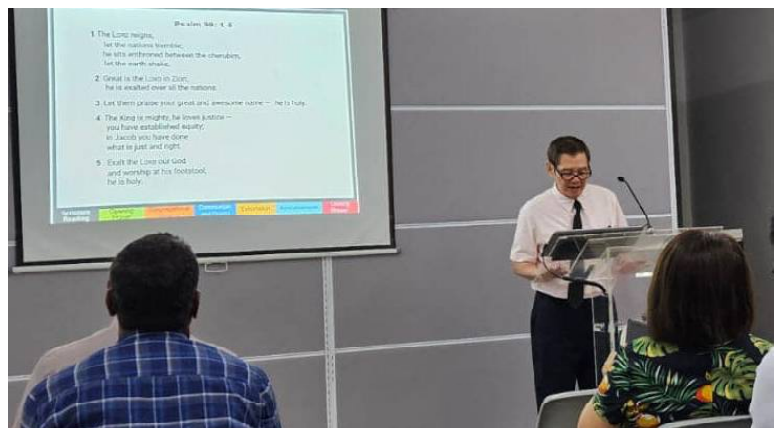
Get To Know Our Worship Leaders

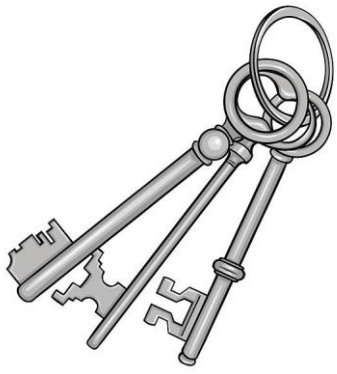

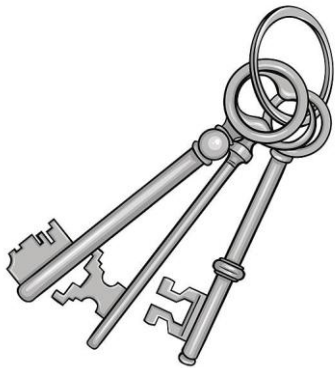
Introduction

KEYS of FAITH

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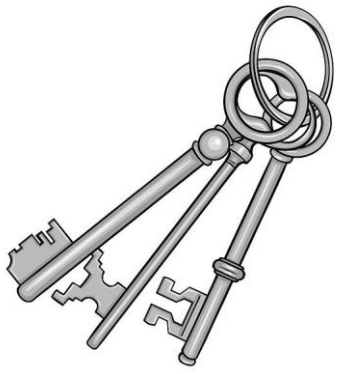
God created us all as free agents.

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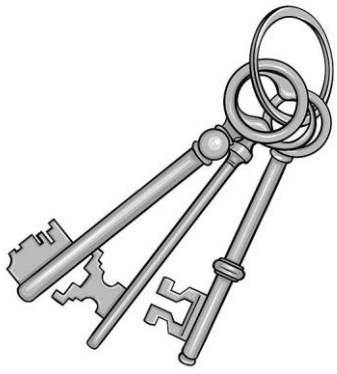
Conclusion
