Follow the steps below to turn your phone into an instant QR code scanner using nothing more than your default camera app. How to scan a QR code on an iPhone Step 1: Open the camera app. Apple's iPhones have integrated QR code scanning capabilities directly into the camera app itself, so there's no need to download a separate separate app unless you really want to. Also, since iOS 12, there's even a direct QR code reader in the Control Center, so you can launch it even faster. If the QR code icon doesn't see the QR code icon in your Control Center on iOS, all you need to do is access the Settings app, tap Control Center, and then tap Personalize Controls. Then find QR Code Reader under the More Controls section, then tap the green icon to add it. Image stabilization technology helps a lot with shaking, but try to avoid moving too much so the code square remains visible. Step 3: Start the code. If you scan a QR code via the QR code reader found in the Control Center, it will automatically launch the corresponding application or website. However, if you use the iOS Camera app to scan the QR code, your iPhone won't automatically initiate QR code activity. Instead, a notification bar will appear at the top of the screen, showing that the QR has been understood, usually with a brief practical description of what the QR code will do - like opening a specific web page. If you think the QR code is safe, tap the notification bar to launch the code activity. How to scan a QR code on an Android Step 1 phone: Check to see if your Android phone supports QR code scanning. Not all Android phones come with this capability yet, so you may have to take a few extra steps before scanning. However, the Google assistant can detect QR codes. Just press the Home icon at length or say OK, Google, then tap the Google Lens icon at the bottom right. If you have a Samsung phone with Bixby capabilities, Bixby can also automatically detect QR codes. If not, you may need to add an app. We suggest you download the QR Code Reader, which is a simple and very effective option (although the one that comes with ads).
