



Bible Exhortation


let's draw near with a true heart in fullness of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and having our body washed with pure water,

let us hold fast the confession of our hope unyieldingly.











How we regard our worship to God indicates the strength of our faith and relationship to God. This is because the key of our faith is wholehearted, sacrificial worship. This is why the apostle Paul says in Romans 12:1 *Therefore I urge you, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service.*

We read in the Bible of some of the deepest and most holy scenes of heaven and human experiences - all of these culminate in worship.

In Isaiah chapter 6, we read of the prophet's vision of heavenly worship, and how it affected him in his call to discipleship. Read the chapter, it will give you a glimpse of heaven.

So it is when the apostle John was taken to heaven and commissioned by God to write what he saw. He could find no scene more stirring than the worship scenes which he selected to document in the book of Revelations.

It is important for Christians to wake up each day and end the day with prayer and to renew devotion to God. In a sense, every day, our lives are a spiritual service to God as we live sacrificially, in a manner that is holy and acceptable to God. The climax of our daily walk is the weekly worship. We are exhorted not to forsake it in Hebrews 10:25.

Audience of One

Worship is not a spectator event, like going to a concert. We are there to worship God and He expects us to give of our best to Him and each other. This is because Jesus said in John 4:24 that *God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth*.

Examine Yourself

How have we been worshipping God so far? Is it the highlight of our week that we anticipate? Do we prepare and give it our very best? Or do we whine when the service is too long and give it a miss when we have something on our schedule? 1 Corinthians 11:30 *For this cause many among you are weak and sickly, and not a few sleep.*



Most of us in Singapore are weathering the current pandemic rather unscathed, but it is not so in many countries. The Household of Faith continues to help churches with benevolent efforts during the pandemic, the most recent, a \$1,000 agape gift to the Pantry Project, by brother Chito Cusi from the Philippines.



The project is an opportunity to show love to our neighbors. It is a community pantry that targets specific indigenous families.

Starting May 10-14, in Banilad, the church will be serving its poorest neighbors during these pandemic times.

We are accepting cash or kind. A tray of eggs cost \$5 (30 medium to large eggs), a can of sardines is \$0.50, a kg of rice is \$1.40, 1/4 kg of bulad (dried fish) is \$0.70, odong noodles is \$0.40 per pack (each pack good for 3-4 families), a kg of squash is \$0.55/

kg, etc.

They have indentified 500 of the poorest families from 5 mountain areas. Daily from Monday to Friday they will serve 100 families.

We pray for more donors so we can support and sustain the Pantry Project.

Poverty is real especially at this time when businesses/stores have closed, restaurants down-sized, and construction projects slowed down.






