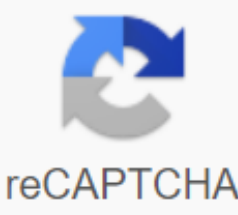

image pixabay oh no, you died and all your inventory is gone! Whether you've finally got eaten by that zombie or you got into a lava pit, having to respawn with scratch elements is not fun. Fortunately, if you know how to keep inventory of Minecraft after you die, then don't suffer this fate again. Keeping your inventory includes using cheat code, which you can easily connect to the console, and it can save you a lot of hassle. You still return to your spawn point when you die, but at least you won't be empty-handed! Before we go into how to keep inventory of Minecraft when you die, let's go through some things you can do without trick code. To protect against the loss of your belongings in the first place, you want to take some of the following habits: Avoid walking around with very valuable items in your personPaga big chest to keep expensive or hard to find itemsDon takes straight down; you can get into a deep cave or in the lava and lose everythingFinish your chest items near the respawn point (your bed) so that you do not forget where you put it If you are going to do something risky, get rid of yourself every item that is not absolutely necessary task you should especially be careful around the lava, because there is no way to return and recover the items if you lose them there. Things that fall into the lava get burned, which is not something you want after working so hard to craft that diamond pickup. How to keep inventory of Minecraft in wooden chest If you run out of the pocket of the room and you are new to Minecraft, you can not understand that you can store more items in the wooden chest. You can make wooden breasts very easily, but first you need to have a wooden craft table and some wooden boards. Harvest some wood from nearby trees and craft them into the boards by pressing E and dropping them into your 2 x 2 crafting grid. Once you have boards, put one in each place in your crafting grid, and you should have processed the table. From there, you can use the remaining boards to craft your chest and store your belongings. To make breasts, take eight wood boards of any kind and put them on your craft table. Arrange them in all grid slots, except in the middle one. You can also keep your loot in these chests if you want; just remember where you put your stuff! Chests can also be convenient when you are mining, because you only have so much space in the pockets for stoned tones that you will accumulate. In theory, you can recover your items even if you don't know how to keep inventory in Minecraft using cheat code. You can just go back to the place where you died and you may notice that your stuff is still floating around waiting for you. It's not always possible though. For example, you might have died somewhere really far from your spawning point, and you don't know how to get there again, or just don't want to travel that far. You've also lost them somewhere dangerous, like in the dungeon, and you don't want to encounter endless skeletons and zombies just to get your stuff back. You can also lose your material somewhere where everything, but it is impossible to recover, for example, a lava flow or an underwater cave that would be difficult to dive. You may notice that this then makes the game too easy. This can solve an annoying problem, but it also deprives you of its incentive to obey the laws of physics in the game. It may not be what you're looking for if you want a challenge, but of course you don't know for sure if you try to play like this. Let's say you just fell off a cliff and your inventory was scattered all over the place. How do you recover it without going to your place of death and picking up all that stuff? Well, in a case like that, it's really too late! To be able to keep your belongings after you die, you will be able to set a cheat command before you die. Once you have lost their belongings, it will be too late to recover them without actually going to the place where they died. If that's what happened to you, then take heart: learn how to keep inventory of Minecraft now, and it won't happen to you again in the future. Here's how to keep inventory in Minecraft after you die: 1. Opening a chat window As it's done will depend on the version of Minecraft that you have, but you will have to open this dialog to be able to link to the software. On your computer, including Windows, Mac, and You can open the chat box by pressing T. Nintendo Switch or Xbox One to press the right arrow button in the D-pad. In Minecraft Pocket Edition, you want to tap the little language bubble icon at the top. 2. Type Cheat Code When the window is open, type the following command into the console: / gamerule keepinventory true Press Enter or which button on your computer is used to confirm, and now the cheat code should take effect. As syntax means, there is basically a binary condition in the software that controls whether you keep your inventory or not, and you find it true. If you want to switch it back to lose your inventory when you die, you can later set it to false. 3. Make sure you make sure you did it now you want to test whether you put the command correctly. Keep all valuable items in your chest only if you want you to have less important things that you don't mind losing in your standard pocket inventory. Now do something to injure your avatar. Do the player jump off the cliff or swim in some water for too long. It doesn't matter what you do; Just make sure you have to spawn the point that you actually want to get back to. Create a bed and sleep in it at night if you want to set your respawn location to somewhere specific. After you die and return, check your inventory to see if the items you have had are still on you. If they are, then you have successfully learned how to maintain inventory in Minecraft! You now always respawn with your belongings after you die unless you set the keepInventory condition back to false. Now you can enjoy walking around at night without fear of losing your stuff, although keep in mind that you always end up waking up to your latest spawning point. Once you know how to keep inventory in Minecraft after you die, the survival method becomes a little easier. You don't have to worry as much about avoiding spiders or falling off huge embankments. You can freely swim under water without risking losing all your belongings if you get lost and can not come up with air. It takes away one of the main challenges of survival mode, but if you're dying a lot lately and you're sick of having to go back looking for all your stuff, it can only be a cheat code that you need. Requirements to run game commands in Minecraft, you have to enable cheats in your world. keepInventory command examples How to enter command 1. Open the Conversation window The easiest way to run a command in Minecraft is in a chat window. Game control to open the chat window depends on the version of Minecraft: Java Edition (PC /Mac), press T KEY to open the chat window. To get Pocket Edition (PE), tap the conversation button at the top of the screen. To use an Xbox One, press the D-Pad controller (right). Press the D-Pad (right) control on the PS4. On the Nintendo Switch press the right button on the controller arrow. To get Windows 10 Edition, press the T key to open the chat window. To get permission for education, press the T key to open the chat window. 2. Enter the command in this example, we will set the gamerule to keep inventory after dying with this command: / gamerule keepInventory true Enter command in the chat window. When you write, you will see the command in the lower left corner of the game window. Press Enter to start the command. The rule of the game will be changed for your world. Now let's see what happens to your inventory when you die in the game. As you can see in the respawn window above, your items are still in your hotbar. You didn't throw them against you when you died this time. Now click the respawn button to reconnect to the game. Here you are back in the game. Your items are still in your hot springs and other inventory lines. You don't have to find where you last died in the game to re-get your belongings. Congratulations, you just learned how to use keepInventory trick to save your inventory items when you die and respawn Minecraft!
