PARTICIPATION

Here are some of the ways you can participate:

Food and Snack stalls (only vegetarian at Shed 6 venue)

If you wish to cook or reheat food for sale at the event you will need to apply for a food stall.

Complete and return a Food Stall Application form by **Friday, 4 September 2020**

Food stalls are very popular and we often receive more applications than we have room for at the Festival. If this happens, we will select stalls using a lottery system.

You will be notified by **Friday, 18 September 2020** if your application is successful.

Cost for a Food Stall:

- Commercial groups (restaurants and private groups): **\$510 + GST**
- Community groups: **\$460 + GST**
- Government agencies: **\$800 + GST**

Retail stalls (Non - Food stalls at TSB Bank Arena venue)

If you wish to sell items such as arts and crafts, CDs, books, henna, or incense, please apply for a retail stall.

Complete and return a Retail Stall Application form by **Friday, 4 September 2020**.

You will be notified by **Friday, 18 September 2020** if your application is successful.

Cost for a Retail Stall:

- Commercial groups (retail shops, clinics and private individuals) **\$350 + GST**
- Community organisations and groups **\$300+ GST**
- Government agencies **\$800+ GST**

Payment for Food and Retail stalls:

Successful vendors will be notified on how to make payment for your stall.

Payments due on the day of the Vendor's Meeting - **Friday, 2 October 2020**. More Information will be provided.
