Minnesota has been linked to the wide receiver and his agent, Ben Dogra, is a former employee of the Vikings, who now works as a lobbyist in the state capitol. Dogra met with the Vikings when the team was considering a trade for him in the 2014 offseason. The most interesting factor in the Vikings' pursuit of Welker is that former general manager Rick Spielman has connections to Dogra and that the two worked on a number of deals together. Spielman hired Dogra to work with the Vikings in the 2014 offseason after he left his role as the team's executive vice president of football operations to become the head of college scouting. Spielman will remain the head of personnel in Minnesota but his former colleague will work directly with him in the capitol. "This is going to be an evolving

process," Spielman told the Pioneer Press in an email. "I will be assessing this situation with Ben and with other members of the front office. There are a lot of moving parts and things are still up in the air. This is still a free agent period, the draft is coming, and all the things that are happening. But I think Ben, as a former employee, is a valuable resource in that regard." Welker caught 47 passes for 513 yards and five touchdowns last season with the Miami Dolphins. He would be a solid addition to Minnesota's offense, particularly on third downs, where he was one of the best in the NFL last season. The 26-year-old also has 11 touchdowns in his career and has caught at least 67 passes each of the past three seasons. There will be a bidding war for Welker in free agency.
