One reason for this is what happens when they have young children. Only about two-thirds of moms with children under 6 work full-time, compared to more than three-quarters of moms whose youngest child is between 6 and 17. Working when balancing the requirements of motherhood is not easy. We've spent decades studying how American families spend their time, why some families are more prone to economic hardship, and what policies help families thrive. We've teamed up to see whether mothers in states with relatively lower childcare costs are more likely than others to work as soon as they have children. State differences in the U.S. family usually pay the full cost of kindergartens, preschools and other programs that take care of children before and after school. These services are expensive everywhere, but the tab is much higher in some places. In states such as California and Washington, childcare tends to be more expensive, and school days are shorter on average. This increases the time or money that families should spend on care. Childcare is one of the biggest spending that gobbles up U.S. family budgets. In New York, it costs three times as much as tuition at a public college or state university. Less time at work looked at mothers' employment and childcare time in U.S. states, analyzing government data collected by the government for 37,993 mothers between 2005 and 2014 to compare their chances of working full-time or part-time during that decade. We found that mothers are more likely to have full-time workers in states where childcare is more affordable. In states with more expensive childcare, more and more mothers work part-time. We also found that mothers spend more time caring for children in states where childcare has been more expensive and as childcare costs have risen over the decade. We believe this means that families are responding to rising care costs by using less, through maternal employment and careers. Many families believe that once their children go to kindergarten, moms and dads can easily return to work without straining the family budget to pay for childcare. This is not always the case, in part because school days rarely coincide with work schedules. This discrepancy varies to some extent because states mandate different minimum lengths for school days. In addition, some public school systems do not prescribe compulsory day care. Even in the states with the longest school days, children stay in school seven o'clock. This does not correspond to the standard eight-hour working days, as well as the time to travel. The discrepancy between working days and school days makes it extremely difficult to synchronize work and family hours. It also means that many Americans pay for caregivers before and after school. Others rely on and friends. We found that mothers were more likely to work part-time in communities where school days were shorter. As school days lengthen, the chances of full-time mothers in this community are increasing. Interestingly, we found that many states where childcare costs more tend to have shorter school days. This means that parents may face more than one greater burden than average on childcare, depending on where they live. All states are not equal. For example, nearly 40 million people living in California have some of the highest average childcare costs, the shortest school days and the lowest full-time maternal employment rates in the country. In contrast, we found that Nebraska has some of the most affordable childcare, long school days, and the highest rates of maternal employment. In Nebraska, an average of 60% of mothers work full-time, compared with 40% in California. And thanks to Nebraska's bipartisan support for child care costs, the state leads the country as child care as well.
