Shadowpath Theatre Productions receives Government of Canada support through My Main Street Community Activator Placemaking Program

June 8, 2022 – Newmarket, ON – Shadowpath is pleased to announce that our Callimachus project was selected for the My Main Street Community Activator program and has received \$25,000 to create a multi-media, roaming play along Main Street Newmarket, providing patrons with iPads to explore the world of Callimachus virtually and with in-person characters.

Through the Government of Canada's My Main Street Community Activator, delivered by the <u>Canadian Urban Institute</u> (CUI), Newmarket will enjoy a more vibrant neighbourhood setting that will draw visitors and increase foot traffic to shops, restaurants and exciting new public spaces. Shadowpath is supported by My Main Street—a two-year, \$23.25-million investment by the Government of Canada through the <u>Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario</u> (FedDev Ontario), delivered by CUI and the <u>Economic Developers Council of Ontario</u> (EDCO).

By delivering a classical play in a contemporary way, Shadowpath will attract 100 participants and collaborate with at least five community partners. Building awareness for female creativity, Shadowpath will provide opportunities for local artists.

Long-term impacts include utilizing the performing arts to enliven everyday spaces with a sense of joy and surprise. By introducing theatre to a downtown core, Shadowpath will generate a big impact on the daily experiences of residents by inspiring pleasant feelings and boosting well-being. As Callimachus pops up throughout Main Street, the sense of the unexpected encourages people to bond with others through an impression of shared experiences. By activating spaces with the spectacle of medieval theatre, curious participants will explore more deeply what Callimachus (and Main Street Newmarket) has to offer.

Callimachus ran from May 6 through 15, 2022 at Newmarket Public Library and travelled to St. Andrew's Church and Cachet Supper Club exploring nooks and alleys via the performing arts along the way.
