NOMINATIONS

Nominees Please!

November 11, 2025, Nomination Night at the General Dinner Meeting. If you have considered running for office or if you know of someone that would as an Officer or Board position, please step forward and submit your/their name(s) to the Search Committee (see below) so it can be announced at the November meeting. Nominations will be taken from The Floor that night as well. Annually, all Officer positions are open comprising Executive Officers, Sergeant-at-Arms, Parliamentarian, and Historian and one Trustee. This year there are 4 Board positions open, one more than normal. Nominees may comprise current elected officials running for re-election.

Because of a recent action (10/14/25) amending the By-Laws, there are two revisions (underlined and in bold print below) to take into consideration in making a nomination: Article V Sec. 2. "All Officers and Directors...shall have been a member in good standing...**for at least three years preceding** the date of the election." And Article V Sec. 6. "**Minimum Requirement for Nomination to the Position of President: Nominee must have served as an Executive Officer (Vice President, Secretary or Treasurer), or a Director for at least one year.**"

Serving the Club can be very rewarding as your actions will help move this institution toward it's 100th Anniversary just a few years ahead. You would be proud to be a part of it. It should be pointed out that Nominations need not come from only those attending the monthly General Dinner Meetings. Any Member can nominate a fellow Member if they feel strongly that he or she will benefit the Club. With over 600 Members, it must be obvious there are Members who have what it takes to serve the Club. Those with financial, marketing and sales, human resources, event planning, and food services industry are especially qualified as well as those that are or have been part of other social oriented institutions. NOTE: the Secretary is a Paid position.

PLEASE give serious consideration to the nominations taking place at the November Dinner Meeting. Any Nominee must have accepted his or her nomination to move forward. If the Nominee cannot attend the November meeting, they Must submit a letter before then acknowledging their nomination so that it can be read at the meeting.

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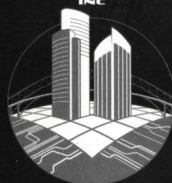
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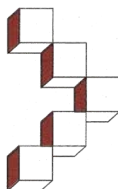


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
