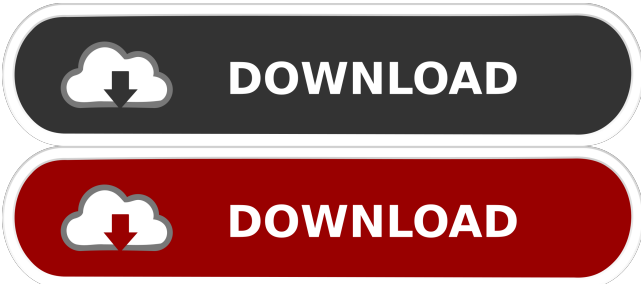

What I need to know is: 01) What is the minimum set of packages required to be installed in order to get the open source nVidia driver? 02) What packages (if any) do I need to add in order to get a "100% stable" driver? Question: I've installed the legacy video driver, however the video card's fan gets pretty loud when I play games like NBA 2k13 or fifa 14.
