Stalls: stalls have drinking, light and first shavings bedding.

Earliest arrival: Wednesday June 14, 2023 – 8.00 am Latest departure: Monday June 19, 2023 – 9.00 am

Distribution of stalls in chronological order of date of reservation.

Every person competing in an AQHA &/OR APHA class must possess a current individual AQHA &/or APHA Membership card or can pay for it at the show, completing a membership application.

AQHA SHW100.5.1 As of June 1, 2023, owners/lessees of horses being shown at an AQHA-approved event, must possess a current AQHA membership in the name of the registered owner/lessee. Entries to be excluded from this requirement are youth rookie, youth Level 1, amateur rookie and amateur Level 1.

Show management must inspect the membership card or a photocopy of it. If the exhibitor and/or the owner is a member but cannot produce

the card at the show, a replacement form must be completed and a new membership purchased at the show prior to entering. The fee is not refundable. The classes will run class in class AQHA and APHA into the order of the classes schedule.





Registration procedures

Enries will only be processed if:

- The entry forms are filled out correctly and have been sent by email in time for the entry deadline
- The entry and stable fees are paid and credited to the account until three days after the entry deadline.
- For all horses outside of Italy, deliver the health certificates to the showoffice and the Traces. The vet papers will be checked locally by the official veterinarian.

By sending the entry, the competitor/exhibitor agrees to comply with the rules and regulations as stated in the show announcement, including the doping concept.

Exhibitors are responsible for knowing their division eligibility. They must accurately complete entry forms and assumes responsability for any errors.

Late entries or changes (horse/rider) have to be declared at the show office until 6 pm the day before the class is scheduled.

Insurance and other Regulations

Every horse must have liability insurance. Elementa Show Rules are to be followed during the show days.

Doping Controls

The Show committee shall arbitrarily choose classes and of those classes, drawn by lot the horse will have to undergo to be tested. The testing procedures will also be determined by the Show committee. By submitting the entry form riders, exhibitors and horse owners agree to their horses being drug tested (blood or urine). In case of violations horse owners, riders and horses will be disqualified from the entire event. Paid entries and stable fees will not be refunded. The horse owner/participant agrees to bear the entire costs of the doping test in case of a positive result and to give back any potential titles, awards and prize money.

Health Requirements

Each horse must be liability insured, free of any epidemic disease and must came from a stable free of any epidemical disease. The horse must be as well vaccinated against influenza and tetanus. The certificate of vaccination must accompany the horse and it has to be produced at the show office upon request. TRACES Certificate (Trade Control and Expert System) and COGGINS are mandatory

Prize money

The ties will be broken through a tie judge. The tie judge will be defined by the showmanagement and published to the exhibitors

Prize money reserved only for Paint Horses.

The first placed Paint Horse in the Amateur and Amateur L1 offered classes, except Halter classes, will receive the Chrome Cash added money, offered by the American Paint Horse Association.
