This speaker has always been affordable and should not be considered a collector's item. Don't pay more than 70 euros in Europe and in France you can get it for as little as 50 euros with a little effort. If you live in the US, it may be justified to pay a little more, but do not pay more than 100 . Don't forget that spare parts are not directly available in the United States.
