The sheets start at the base leg angle always stacking horizontal, which is the easiest way to visualize whether the angle is sharp or blunt. Earlier sheets also avoid angles that aren't quite at right angles (if the angle is really at right angles) to make the sharp/blunt definition more obvious. Subsequent sheets have a base angle rotating a bit that requires more spatial thinking, and the final set of sheets has angles that are near the right angles and may require the protractor to determine if there are sharp or blunt. Measuring the corners of the WorksheetsEach corners of the sheet in this section also provide great practice for measuring angles with the protractor. The actual angle is provided on the key answer, so in addition to revealing whether the angle is blunt or sharp, you can offer students a measure angle with the protractor and delivery measurements as part of their work.
