

WHAT DRIVES US

The suicide pandemic has become an unavoidable reality across the nation. We've noticed an increased demand over the years for non-clinical professionals to undertake efforts and responsibilities to address mental health concerns outside their scope of training.

About the Course

Method of Training

Our online training model integrates a clinically minded focus with a design conducive and applicable to high school and college students.

Our training format is congruent with many course materials students have/will receive in their regular academic studies.

Students have remote access to the training modality and can independently complete the course at their own pace.


The entry level course is not designed to supplement clinical treatment, but rather to train individuals to be part of a support network and to encourage help seeking behaviors for individuals with a higher safety concern.

How It Works

The Pilot Program

Our See-Say-Do pilot program will offer FREE access to our entry level course to qualified high school and college students.

Through a multi-pronged approach we will (1) develop connections with select schools and institutions in states most impacted by high suicide rates, (2) offer Suicide Prevention Liaison Certification to all students that successfully complete the course, (3) provide social media branding materials to be distributed and shared by all certified liaisons, and (4) synthesize the data and compile an individualized final report available to each selected site upon completion of the entire pilot program.

We require that each institution designate a site coordinator who will communicate directly with our executive director throughout the program. The site coordinator will be responsible for internally distributing access to the course and follow-up materials to all qualified participants.

Advanced Course:
