
Strict Covid-19 Guidelines



With the current infection-free record among the community and the rapid rollout of the vaccine, there is every likelihood that religious worship restrictions will be further relaxed. Until then, we are abiding by the strict Covid-19 Guidelines at the Launchpad.



- 2. Your temperature will be taken to ensure you do not have a fever.
- 3. Masks will be required and only the worship team can take them off while serving. No singing is permitted, but you can follow the songleader silently.
- 4. Only family/one household can sit together. All others will sit a metre apart.
- 5. No fellowship after worship, but up to 8 can enjoy the food at a table at Timbre+.

The "New" Household of Faith



We recently returned to the Metropolitan YMCA to remove the belongings stored at the Upper Room. Not only was our cabinet stuffed with all kinds of things (including an oven toaster), more boxes were piling on top of that too.

I have always been impressed with how our Lord Jesus, given His all-important mission, was able to travel light. No complicated organisation, no immoveable assets, no months-in-advance schedules.

Even though the Household of Faith is a brand new congregation, in the short space of 3 years, we have acculumated so much stuff. While keeping proper accounts, we have organised activities, published books and literature, set up websites, Facebook groups and WhatsApp chats, responded to appeals etc.

I can go on and on, but now is a good time to start afresh, in a new location with less stuff and baggage. You can call this the Household of Faith Lite.

1. New location: We started out in 2017 renting Sunday meeting slots from the Salvation Army, and then the Metropolitan YMCA. Although these non-profit Christian organisations had the best rates in town, for a new church with an average attendance of 30, it cost us \$25 per pax just for the Sunday 4-hour rental.

We are now given free rental in the new location and full access during the week. We want to start paying rent when we move into larger premises, but even the rent will be a small percentage from what we used to pay.

- 2. New setup: Instead of publishing and storing leaflets, books and materials, we will post softcopies of 90% of our materials on the www.hofsg.com website for members and visitors to access 24/7 from anywhere. We will only publish in hardcopies a weekly bulletin and a quarterly devotional quide.
- 3. Activities: We have already started in-person worship last Sunday in our new location and will continue to live stream the worship. In the works are the resumption of Care teams and Bible classes when restrictions are further eased by the government.

Currently, we are calling on all members and visitors to return to in-person worship at least once a month. When restrictions are further eased, we look forward to accomodating more people in our current meeting place and resuming the weekly potluck. There is a fellowship area right outside the door, with a drink machine and hot/cold water dispenser.

Let us return to worship and rebuild the Household of Faith.

A Year of Live Streaming



Since 5th April 2020, when the Household of Faith were no longer permitted at the Metropolitan YMCA, we started immediately to live stream our worships, first from the home of the Alfred Poons, then from my office at Pasir Panjang. In recent weeks, we live streamed from the Launchpad.

While the transition appears seamless and well executed, I want to thank brother Barnabas Thng for devoting his time, expertise and equipment to help us in our hour of need.

The pandemic took us all by surprise, and there were many things that we needed to adjust, in order to comply with the new guidelines. Brother Barnabas was there for us and assisted us each step of the way.

Now that we have resumed in-person worship, we are thankful to brother Barnabas for the use of his office, and the effort he put in to set it up for the maximum number of worshippers, keeping his own furniture to the minimum.

While the new location will serve the needs of the Household of Faith for the time being, brother Barnabas has applied for a larger office, two blocks away. When it becomes available, we will be able to accomodate many more and not restrict the number of worshippers.

Sermon Videos

I had always wanted to make our sermons available on our website but until the pandemic have not made the effort to record them during our worships. Live streaming gave us the opportunity, and a new mobile-friendly website provided the platform to share them.

All recent sermon videos are linked to the Facebook posts as it allows for more interactive responses. The videos are not only available for viewing at any time, but anyone can comment and look at comments that have been left by others.

We will be adding links every month of recent sermon videos, so no matter what Facebook does, viewers can always view the sermon videos from the links at the Boxcast storage.












