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Review InformationTime Played: 20 hoursPlatform: PS4In Game 5 of the 1997 NBA Finals, Michael Jordan scored a match-leading 38 points while sweating profusely and sometimes off the court due to illness, only to return moments later and resume his dominance in the game. Although Jordan actually suffers from food poisoning, the game has become known in the annals of basketball history as The Flu Game. NBA 2K21 feels very much like a flu game. It's mostly brilliant, but wherever it is, it's an absolute mess. It's not the flu or food poisoning that makes NBA 2K21 patients though; it's VC. Actual basketball in NBA 2K21 is sublime, with the series continuing to do little tweaks and improvements with each installment. This year, some of the annoying off-limits scenarios have been tightened, but the biggest change is shooting. While the shooting button still exists, the shooting stick tends to give closer control, and after the initial punishing curve of difficulty, the quickly realized hotfix makes it run much smoother. On the court, you couldn't ask for more. Out of court, it's a different story. VC (or Virtual Currency) flows through everything, blocking some difficulties in otherwise top-class MyCareer mode, and forcing you to choose between either upgrading myCareer Pro, or improving myTeam registry. Of course, the game really wants you to do both, but for this you will have to spend more real money in the game. It's not just that microtransactions are present, it's that the game pushes them so hard that it damages your enjoyment of MyCareer, puts barriers ahead of your access to your neighborhood, and sees most standalone modes of loss. The NBA 2K series has always been half a step ahead of FIFA (and a couple ahead of Madden) in terms of raw sports simulation. After tightening defenses last year, taking home the crown as the best sports sim on the market should have been an easy alley-oop for NBA 2K21. It feels like they missed a dunk but put in the rebound. Minute to minute, play to play, shot-in-shot, NBA 2K21 is seamless. It's as close to perfect as you can really imagine a sporty sim can be. Passing, running, and defensive work are as clean and asquick as they were last year, but this addition brought in stick shooting with the usual play button, as well as changes change The camera is looking and running. With this change comes a new dribbling system that definitely offers more control and feels more fluid. However, if you've tried shooting either in the demo or on the day of the NBA 2K21 launch, you'll know that they have massively digested the difficulties. Dame Lillard lacked open jump shots when the goal was yellow; In the 2K sighting system, yellow means very close, but not perfect. It has been fixed since then, and shooting is much more natural. Stick still takes getting used to, but the punishment for getting yellow isn't too harsh if you're in a box and not in a hot zone, or using a player with poor shooting stats. The matches themselves, filled with sponsorships from Gatorade, Mobil, and more, can sometimes lean too much towards presenting a live game on TV than the actual game, but once you have a rock in your hands that disappears. Not really, and we'll get on with other weaknesses in time, but the beginning and end of a large share of NBA 2K21 issues stem from the microtransactions the game is built around. You can't blame 2K neglect on court play, but all the roads seem to bring back to MyTeam, and the ability of players to spend more real money. One of the game modes is MyTeam, a card game for team building where you have to buy players, contracts, jerseys and everything else that you can think of, either in blind packages or in separate auctions. The game is constantly pulling you to this; we took the Trail Blazers to the final in MyLeague, our player in MyCareer just reached the NBA and we did a little more than try the myTeam features, and so far every time we turned the game, the menu pulled us to MyTeam with the Continue button now. In our pre-order bonus packages, we got a strong team - Kobe, Shaq, Lillard, Williamson, and Ingram - but once we started buying real packages, the quality of the players on offer sank quickly. You can have a decent time playing some offline 3v3, earning minimum coins while working on your skills, but to really get the most out of MyTeam, you need to play online. This means that you need to constantly buy - often for real money, although grinding is possible - new And packages. VC can be earned for free, but it takes a long time to earn even one package which, in this lootbox system, can end up VC in the sewer. Even MyCareer, the game's history mode, is infected with VC. Everything your player does earns you some VC and you can spend it on updating your player or saving it for packages. It's a bad design - and it feels intentional - that you can use MyCareer to make MyTeam better, but for that in the long run, you have to try to compete in the NBA with a low-profile skill score that is spent on virtual contracts to make sure you can continue to play online with Kevin Durant. You can't switch the difficulty down past the Pro either so you don't earn too many VC coins and games this system. This, especially, looks like a vicious move. Williams, Djimon Hounsou, and Jesse Williams. The latter is too intense at times, but it feels like a real production, tells compelling stories without overdoing melodrama, and offers some satisfying story beats. It's too scripted in places, but it's a minor criticism in sports drama. No matter how good it is, though, the lack of a full range of difficulties is in vain gatekeeps newcomers out of what should be a welcoming mode, and it can't shake the sense that a complex maze is designed to bring you back to MyTeam, so that a playoff winning 3-pointer is worth no more than a few coins to the next pack. MyCareer is also home to Neighborhood, a return online game mode built around street ball and creativity. Offline, you can bring back some of that feeling in the park, but it's not quite the same. Neighborhood is a decent game mode itself, but it has too many flaws to really justify the praise. On the one hand, you can only access through MyCareer with your professional, who again brings to the question of where to spend VC. It also may not be available until you reach the NBA, which means either skipping by far the most interesting and personal part of the story mode story, or playing through more slowly and not accessing perhaps the most interesting online mode until you have a few hours in a story that barely connects to the neighborhood in the first place. Neighborhood is a representative of NBA 2K21 in general, in that basketball is great, but every decision made around it brings the side down. Verdict (Image 2K Games)NBA 2K21 is not a three-and-a-half star game. It's a five-star match and the two stars of the game are scored together. Basketball is almost perfectly suited, especially with shooting difficulties being smoothed out, and and top of the sports tree sim. But any other design choice is either there to make you spend more money on MyTeam or just outright bad design. There is a great basketball game here, with almost flawless gameplay and compelling storytelling.
