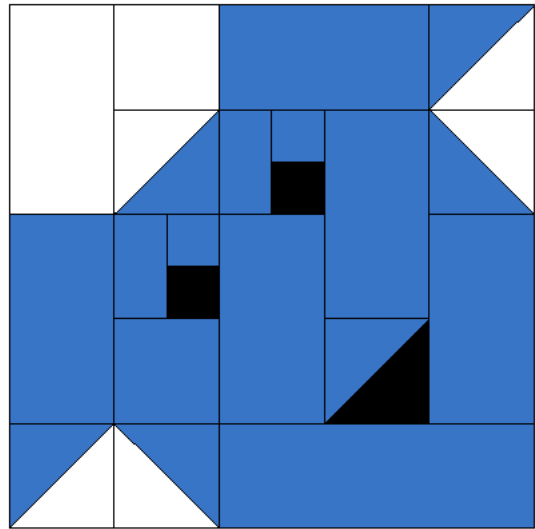

July 2021 Block of the Month: Puppy Faces

Furry friends are always a fun addition to our quilting queue, and this month we have cute little puppy faces for you to make. The finished size for this block is 15". You do not need to trim your blocks before turning them in. Feel free to use applique to embellish your block, but please, no 3D embellishments such as buttons or charms.

Fabric Selection: Please use solid white or a white-on-white print for the background and solid black or a black-on-black print for the eyes and nose of your pup. But nothing says that the puppies have to be traditional pooch colors. Feel free to make your puppies in whatever fabric you like.



Rotary Cutting:

Cut your fabrics as listed below:

	Size	Puppy Fabric	Background Fabric	Eye/Nose Fabric
A	3.5" x 6.5"	5 patches	1 patch	--
B	3.5" x 3.5"	1 patch	1 patch	--
C	4" x 4"	6 patches	5 patches	1 patch
D	3.5" x 9.5"	1 patch	--	--
E	3.5" x 2"	2 patches	--	--
F	2" x 2"	2 patches	--	2 patches

1. Use your C square patches to make half-square triangles. You will make 5 puppy/background combinations and 1 puppy/nose combination.
 - a. Place fabric squares right sides together
 - b. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other
 - c. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on either side of the diagonal line
 - d. Cut along the drawn line and press open. Trim your finished half-square triangles to measure 3.5" square.



2. Assemble the block using diagram below and/or the illustration on page 1. Use a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam throughout.
