T.F. hosts Pacific Northwest boxing tournament

TWIN FALLS—It's one of the most compelling aspects of boxing—how months, often years of monastic work can either be rewarded or derailed over the span of several minutes in a critical bout.

For the amateur boxer, few fights hold more importance than those of a major advancement tournament, such as the USA Pacific Northwest Regionals to be held in the CSI Gymnasium Feb. 10 and 11.

Lasse, go home, Win, and it's on to the national tournament March 4-12 in Colorado Springs.

Twin Falls Jerry Garcia knows the drill with last year's regional, but he's young. Under-19 National Championships to show for it.

The 17-year-old southpaw from the Southern Idaho Brit-Cann boxing club is well

aware of what's at stake.

"It means a lot," said Garcia. "Because if I win this tournament, I get to go to nationals and hopefully get some more amateur points which determine national rankings."

Brit-Cann trainer Jason Samrags, a coach for last year's regional team, feels his fighter's success will depend largely on conditioning and mental preparation.

"It's got to get his conditioning up," said Samrags. "He's going to be fighting at least two

days. He's got some guys coming that want to beat him. He's got to have the heart and the determination to get there."

Also representing Idaho will be several fighters from the Gate City Boxing club in Pocatello: Chris Osborne (141), Cody De Los Reyes (165), and Adrian Farmer (201).

"They're going to be up against it," said Ron Eaton, Gate City manager and trainer. "The people that make it that far are pretty good boxers."

After climbing the USA Junior Olympic rankings to ninth in the nation, with his 17th birthday Osborne recently transferred into the senior classification and the tournament will mark his first major test against the pros.

"It's speed is deceptive," said Eaton. "You almost have to be in the ring to see how fast he is. He's a good counter puncher. He'll just grow as he gets older."

For De Los Reyes, 21, results

will depend on how fast he's able to shed the rust accumulated on his LHS mission to Spain. He's logged two fights since returning early in the year and looked physically impressive in his state title victory over Devin Falls' Miguel Flores Jan. 20 in Twin Falls.

"He'll get better," said Eaton. "It's not completely in shape yet, but it'll take a pretty good boy to beat him."

Ring time is a similar impediment for Farmer, who garnered an untested berth to the tournament.

"Unfortunately for our neck of the woods it's tough to get super heavyweight," said Eaton. "So he doesn't get in the ring too often."

"He's got a hard nose, he's got quick hands, and he's in great shape," Eaton said. "I think those people at nationals better be watching for him."

Jurors reject Anaheim's claim in Angels dispute

SANTA ANA, Calif.—A jury ruled Thursday that the Angels are not entitled to a contract with the city of Anaheim when the baseball team changed its name.

Jurors, who deliberated about five hours, also found the team did not violate a state law requiring good faith and fair dealing when it changed its name last year from Anaheim Angels to Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim.

The jury officials filed suit for breach of contract last January. Shortly after Angels owner Art Moreno made the switch.

The city claimed the change cost it at least \$100 million in lost tourism, publicity and so-called "impressions"—buzz that appears in the national media in conjunction with the press box could stop games to view the field.

Jurors rejected Anaheim's claim that the team violated a 1996 stadium lease agreement to that name.

Although the language said only the name shall "include" the word Anaheim, the city officials claimed The Walt Disney Co., which sold the team to Moreno in 2003, violated the lease by changing the name to Los Angeles Angels and signed a 1996 stadium lease agreement to that name.

NCAA approves press box instant replay

Boozer plans return before All-Star break

SALT LAKE CITY—Carlos Boozer doesn't want to wait until after the All-Star break to play his first game in nearly a year.

Boozer, who missed the first 49 games with a strained hamstring, said he will play Friday night when the Utah Jazz visit the Minnesota Timberwolves.

"I don't know how long I'll play. You've got to ask Coach that. But I'll be in the game," Boozer said before practice Thursday.

Coach Jerry Sloan, who along with the Jazz training staff will have the final say on Boozer's comeback, said it would depend on the team's condition Friday in Minneapolis.

After several setbacks with Boozer's rehabilitation since he last played in 2004, Boozer hasn't played since last Feb. 14, when he strained his right foot during a game at Phoenix. Boozer said his foot was healthy by the end of the season and was ready for training camp, but he strained his left hamstring and missed the preseason.

Boozer returns to practice Wednesday and took part in a 4-minute scrimmage.

He said Thursday the hamstring felt fine when he worked up and he expected to be ready for the Timberwolves.

Whisenhunt, Petrino not interested in Raiders

ALAMEDA, Calif.—Super Bowl winning offensive coordinator Ken Whisenhunt and Louisville coach Bobby Petrino have pulled out of consideration for the Oakland Raiders coaching vacancy.

Whisenhunt came to the Bay Area to interview Wednesday with owner Al Davis and then coach Tom Cable. Petrino was also interviewed Wednesday by Cable.

Longhorns coach Mack Brown gets pay raise

AUSTIN, Texas—Texas football coach Mack Brown got a \$250,000 pay raise Thursday after leading the Longhorns to their first outright national championship in six years.

The 54-year-old Brown agreed to a 10-year deal with the school's end of the 2004 season that boosts his salary to \$100,000 a year.

The raise is significantly above the \$75,000 annual expansion and renovation project that will increase the top coaching candidate's salary from \$80,000 to more than \$60,000.
