Called Out : Discovering God's Purpose for You

Why am I here?

What is my purpose in
life?

Introduction

You were not created by accident!

The journey of discovering God's purposes is not about figuring life out on your own.

It's about surrendering to the One who already knows the plan!

Jeremiah 1:5(NIV)

*Before I formed you in the womb I knew you,
before you were born I set you apart;
I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.*

1. You Are Known and Set Apart

God knew you before you knew yourself

He formed you intentionally – your personality, your gifts and your story.

This means you have inherent value and divine purpose from the beginning

To be “called out” is to be “set apart”

Not everyone understands your calling because it’s not theirs to carry

Stop comparing your life to others – God’s calling is personal and specific

Ephesian 2:10 (NLT)

For we are God’s masterpiece.

He has created us anew in Christ Jesus,

so we can do good things he planned for us long ago.



2. Your Calling Is Connected to Christ

Purpose is discovered in the presence of God.

Jesus is not just your Saviour – He’s your guide, your anchor, and your model.

Many people chase careers or comfort, but purpose is found in Christ.

It’s less about what you do and more about who you are becoming.

God is more concerned with your character than your title. Identity precedes impact.

Romans 8: 28-30 (NIV) *“and we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose...”*

Isaiah 64:8 (NIV) *Yet you, LORD, are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter, we are all the work of your hand.*





3. The Call Requires Your Response.

God does not force – He invites.

The call of God must be answered with surrender.

You don't need all the answers to say "yes". You need faith.

Obedience unlocks clarity.

As you walk in obedience, purpose unfolds.

Small steps of faith lead to great doors of destiny.

Isaiah 6 :8 (NIV)

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?"

And I said "Here am I, Send me!"

4. Your Purpose Impacts Others

You are called not just to something, but for someone

Your life is a bridge to God for others- eg family,
community, even strangers

Your purpose will bless others when you live it boldly.

John 21:15-17

*Three times Jesus asked Peter “Do you love (agape) me”,
yet Peter could only confess I love (Philos) you. The Lord’s
reply :*

v15 **Feed my sheep**

v16 **Take care of my sheep**

v17 **Feed my sheep.**

4. Your Purpose Impacts Others

Don't underestimate the influence of a faithful life.

Every act of obedience has ripple effects in the kingdom of God.

1 Thessalonians 5:11-14 Positive reinforcement

V11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

V12 Now we ask you, brothers and sisters, to acknowledge those who work hard among you, who care for you in the Lord and admonish you.

V13 Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their of their work. Live in peace with each other.

V14 And we urge you, brothers and sisters, warn those who are idle and disruptive, encourage the disheartened, help the weak, be patient with everyone.



Conclusion

Matt 4:18-22 God is calling you--- by name, for a purpose, and into a life only you can live.

You were made for more than survival. You were made for significance. The time to answer is now!

1. Give your immediate obedience

Called Simon Peter and Andrew, they “immediately left their nets and followed Him”.

Genesis 12:1-4 *God called Abram to leave his county, and “so Abram went forth as the Lord had spoken to him*

2. Be Ready to Act

Isaiah 55: 6 *Seek the Lord while he may be found; call upon him while he is near.*

Micah 6:8 A reminder that the daily response to God involves the call to “act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God

3. Overcome your Hesitation

Isaiah 6:8 When God asks “Whom shall I send?” the appropriate reply is, “Here am I! Send me”

Jeremiah 1:4-10 Jeremiah initially hesitated, claiming to be too young, but God provided reassurance promising to put His words in Jeremiah’ mouth.
